### 1. Introduction

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the safe and proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your PERLESMITH Corner TV Wall Mount Bracket, model PSCMF1. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation to ensure correct assembly and to prevent potential damage or injury. Keep this manual for future reference.

### 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

**WARNING:** Failure to read and follow all instructions can result in personal injury, property damage, or voiding of your warranty. If you do not understand these instructions or have doubts about the safety of the installation, please contact PERLESMITH customer support or a qualified installer.

- Do not install this product on walls that are not structurally sound.
- Ensure the mounting surface can safely support the combined weight of the mount and the television.
- Always use a stud finder to locate wood studs accurately. Do not rely on visual estimation.
- Verify that the VESA mounting pattern of your TV is compatible with this mount (Max VESA 400x400mm).
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 99 lbs (45 kg).
- Keep all small parts away from children.
- Use only the hardware provided or specified by PERLESMITH.
- Tighten all screws firmly but do not overtighten. Overtightening can damage screws and components.
- This product is intended for indoor use only.

### 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present and undamaged before beginning installation. If any parts are missing or defective, contact PERLESMITH customer support.




Image: Overview of the PERLESMITH Corner TV Wall Mount Bracket and its components, including the main mount assembly, TV brackets, and a spirit level.



### 5. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

### 5.1 Pre-Installation Checks

- TV Compatibility: This mount supports TVs from 26 to 60 inches, weighing up to 99 lbs (45 kg).
- VESA Compatibility: Compatible VESA patterns include 200x100mm, 200x200mm, 300x200mm, 300x300mm, 400x200mm, 400x400mm. Measure the distance between the mounting holes on the back of your TV.
- Wall Type: This mount is designed for installation on wood studs, concrete, or brick walls.DO NOT install on drywall alone.



### 5.2 Attaching TV Brackets to TV

- 1. Carefully place your TV face-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent screen damage.
- 2. Identify the correct diameter and length of screws (M4, M6, or M8) that fit your TV's mounting holes. Use washers and spacers if necessary to ensure a snug fit without overtightening.
- 3. Attach the left and right TV brackets to the back of your TV using the selected screws. Ensure the brackets are centered and level.

### **5.3 Wall Plate Installation (Corner Mounting)**

This mount is specifically designed for corner installations, allowing for flexible placement in both inside and outside corners, as well as offset walls.

#### 1. Locate Studs/Mark Holes:

- For wood stud installation: Use a stud finder to locate the center of the wood studs in the desired corner. Mark
  the drilling points for the wall plates. Ensure the stud spacing is appropriate for the mount (if your wood stud
  spacing exceeds 16 inches, refer to model PSXFK1).
- For concrete/brick installation: Mark the drilling points directly on the wall.

### 2. Drill Pilot Holes:

- For wood studs: Drill pilot holes using a 7/32 inch (5.5mm) drill bit to a depth of 2.75 inches (70mm).
- For concrete/brick: Drill pilot holes using a 3/8 inch (10mm) masonry drill bit to a depth of 2.95 inches (75mm). Insert concrete anchors into the holes, ensuring they are flush with the wall surface.

### 3. Attach Wall Plates:

• Align the left and right wall plates with the drilled pilot holes.

- Secure the wall plates to the wall using the provided lag bolts and washers. Tighten firmly with a socket wrench, but do not overtighten.
- Use the included spirit level to ensure the wall plates are perfectly level before fully tightening.




Image: Step-by-step illustration of securing the wall plates to the chosen wall type, including drilling and fastening.

### 5.4 Hanging the TV

- 1. With assistance, carefully lift the TV with the attached brackets and hook them onto the TV plate of the wall mount.
- 2. Ensure the TV brackets are securely seated on the TV plate.
- 3. Tighten the safety screws located at the bottom of the TV brackets to prevent accidental dislodgement.

## 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (ADJUSTMENTS)

Your PERLESMITH Corner TV Wall Mount offers various adjustments for optimal viewing.

- **Tilt Adjustment:** The mount allows for a tilt range of +5° to -10°. Loosen the tilt knobs on the TV plate, adjust the TV to the desired angle, and then retighten the knobs to secure.
- Swivel Adjustment: The articulating arms allow the TV to swivel up to 45° left or right (maximum swivel angle depends on TV size). Gently push or pull the TV to the desired viewing angle.
- Extension and Retraction: The mount can extend up to 24 inches (61 cm) from the wall and retract to 2.2 inches (5.6 cm). Carefully pull the TV forward or push it back towards the wall.
- **Post-Installation Leveling:** The TV plate can be adjusted +/-3° for fine-tuning the horizontal level after installation. Loosen the leveling screws, adjust the TV, and retighten.

### 7. MAINTENANCE

- Periodically check that all screws and connections are secure. Retighten if necessary.
- Clean the mount with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Ensure the articulating arms move smoothly. If movement becomes stiff, a small amount of silicone-based lubricant can be applied to the pivot points.

### 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
TV is not level after installation.	Wall plates not perfectly level, or post-installation leveling not adjusted.	Use the post-installation leveling feature (+/-3°) to fine-tune. Loosen leveling screws, adjust, then retighten.
Mount feels loose or unstable.	Screws not fully tightened, or incorrect wall type/anchors used.	Ensure all lag bolts and TV bracket screws are securely tightened. Verify installation on appropriate wall type (wood stud, concrete, brick). Do not install on drywall alone.
TV does not fit the mount.	Incorrect TV size or VESA pattern.	Confirm your TV's size (26-60 inches) and VESA pattern (max 400x400mm) are compatible with this mount.
Difficulty adjusting tilt/swivel.	Tilt knobs too tight, or pivot points need lubrication.	Loosen tilt knobs before adjusting. Apply a small amount of silicone- based lubricant to articulating joints if movement is stiff.


