INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Godrej 190 L 5 Star Direct Cool Single Door Refrigerator. This appliance is designed to provide efficient and reliable cooling for your food and beverages. This manual contains important information regarding the installation, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your refrigerator. Please read it thoroughly before using the appliance and keep it for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury when using your refrigerator, follow these basic precautions:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Ensure the refrigerator is connected to a properly grounded electrical outlet.
- Do not attempt to repair or replace any part of your refrigerator unless specifically recommended in this manual. All other servicing should be referred to a qualified technician.
- Keep ventilation openings, in the appliance enclosure or in the built-in structure, clear of obstruction.
- Do not use mechanical devices or other means to accelerate the defrosting process, other than those recommended by the manufacturer.
- Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.
- Do not use electrical appliances inside the food storage compartments of the appliance, unless they are of the type recommended by the manufacturer.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Unpacking

Carefully remove all packaging materials, including foam and adhesive tape. Dispose of packaging materials responsibly. Ensure no parts are missing or damaged. Keep packaging materials away from children.

Placement

Choose a location that is strong enough to support the refrigerator when fully loaded. Allow adequate space around the refrigerator for proper ventilation (at least 10 cm on sides and back, 30 cm at top). Avoid direct sunlight, heat sources (like stoves or radiators), and damp areas. Ensure the refrigerator is placed on a level surface to prevent vibrations and ensure proper door closure.

Electrical Connection

Before plugging in the refrigerator, ensure the voltage and frequency match the specifications on the rating label. Use a

dedicated, grounded power outlet. Do not use extension cords or multiple outlet adapters. Allow the refrigerator to stand upright for at least 2-4 hours before plugging it in to allow the refrigerant to settle.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Initial Startup

After connecting the power, the refrigerator will start cooling. It may take several hours for the internal temperature to reach the desired level. Avoid placing food inside during the first 2-3 hours of operation.

Temperature Control

Your refrigerator is equipped with a temperature control knob, usually located inside the fresh food compartment. Turn the knob to adjust the cooling intensity. A higher number typically indicates colder temperatures. Start with a medium setting and adjust as needed based on ambient temperature and food load.

Direct Cool Defrosting

This is a direct cool refrigerator, which requires manual defrosting. Frost will accumulate on the freezer walls over time. When the frost layer becomes about 5mm thick, it's time to defrost. To defrost:

1. Turn off the refrigerator and unplug it from the power outlet.
2. Remove all food items and place them in a cooler or another refrigerator.
3. Leave the refrigerator door open to allow the frost to melt naturally. You can place towels at the bottom to absorb water.
4. Once all frost has melted, clean and dry the interior thoroughly.
5. Plug the refrigerator back in and allow it to cool for a few hours before returning food items.

Food Storage Guidelines

Organize food efficiently to maximize cooling and freshness.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Exterior Cleaning

Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft cloth dampened with mild soap and water. Dry thoroughly. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that can damage the finish.

Interior Cleaning

Clean the interior regularly with a solution of baking soda and warm water (1 tablespoon baking soda to 1 liter water). Rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly. Remove shelves and drawers for easier cleaning. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive pads.

Door Gasket Care

Clean the door gaskets regularly to ensure a tight seal. Use a soft cloth and mild soap and water. A clean gasket helps maintain cooling efficiency and prevents frost buildup.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, check the following common issues:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Refrigerator not cooling	Power cord unplugged; temperature control set too warm; door left open; excessive food load.	Check power connection; adjust temperature setting; ensure door is closed properly; reduce food load.
Excessive noise	Refrigerator not level; items vibrating inside; compressor noise (normal).	Adjust leveling feet; rearrange items; compressor noise is normal during operation.
Water leakage inside/outside	Drain hole blocked (during defrost); door gasket not sealing properly.	Clear drain hole; clean and inspect door gasket for damage.
Door not closing properly	Food packages obstructing; door gasket dirty or damaged; refrigerator not level.	Rearrange food; clean/replace gasket; level the refrigerator.


