INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the Zerone Universal Remote Control, model 8541714994. Designed for compatibility with various Smart TVs, LCD, and LED televisions, this remote serves as a direct replacement or an additional control unit. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper operation and to maximize your product experience.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Zerone Universal Remote Control is engineered for ease of use and broad compatibility. It features a standard layout with dedicated buttons for common TV functions, including power, volume, channel control, navigation, and smart TV access. Its ergonomic design ensures comfortable handling.

SETUP

Battery Installation

The remote control requires two AAA batteries (not included) for operation. Follow these steps to install the batteries:

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
2. Gently slide the battery cover downwards or press the latch and lift to open it.
3. Insert two AAA batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the markings inside the compartment.
4. Replace the battery cover by sliding it back into place until it clicks securely.

Note: Always use new batteries and replace both batteries at the same time. Do not mix old and new batteries or different types of batteries.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This universal remote control is designed to work with most Smart TVs, LCD, and LED televisions without requiring complex programming. Simply insert the batteries, and it should function directly with compatible devices.

Button Functions

- **Power Button (⏻):** Turns the TV on or off.

- **Play/Pause, Rewind, Fast Forward:** Media playback controls.
- **GUIDE:** Accesses the electronic program guide.
- **3D:** Activates or deactivates 3D mode (if supported by TV).
- **AMBILIGHT:** Controls Ambilight features (for compatible Philips TVs).
- **SOURCE:** Selects input sources (HDMI, AV, etc.).
- **TV:** Switches to TV mode.
- **SMART TV:** Accesses Smart TV features and apps.
- **FORMAT:** Changes screen format/aspect ratio.
- **LIST:** Displays channel list or other lists.
- **INFO:** Displays program information.
- **Navigation Pad (Up, Down, Left, Right, OK):** Navigates menus and confirms selections.
- **EXIT:** Exits current menu or function.
- **OPTIONS:** Accesses context-sensitive options.
- **CH+/CH-:** Changes channels up or down.
- **Volume Up/Down:** Adjusts volume.
- **Mute:** Mutes or unmutes audio.
- **Number Buttons (0-9):** Direct channel selection or text input.
- **Color Buttons (Red, Green, Yellow, Blue):** Access specific functions within menus or applications.
- **SUBTITLE:** Toggles subtitles on/off.
- **TEXT:** Accesses teletext (if available).

For specific functions related to your TV model, refer to your television's user manual.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

To maintain the remote control's appearance and functionality:

- Wipe the surface with a soft, dry cloth.
- For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive cleaning pads, as these can damage the remote's finish or internal components.

Battery Replacement

Replace batteries when the remote's response becomes sluggish or it stops functioning. Refer to the "Battery Installation" section under Setup for detailed instructions. Always dispose of used batteries responsibly according to local regulations.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Zerone Universal Remote Control, consult the following table for common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Remote does not work at all.	Batteries are dead or incorrectly inserted. Remote is too far from the TV or obstructed.	Check and replace batteries, ensuring correct polarity. Move closer to the TV and ensure no objects block the signal path.
Some buttons do not respond.	Button malfunction. TV not compatible with specific advanced functions.	Try pressing the button firmly. Verify if your TV model supports the specific function (e.g., 3D, Ambilight).
Remote works intermittently.	Low battery power. Infrared (IR) sensor on TV is obstructed or dirty.	Replace batteries. Clean the IR sensor on your TV.
