# Salter 9193 BK3R Electronic Bathroom Scale User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the Salter 9193 BK3R Electronic Bathroom Scale. This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your new scale. Please read these instructions thoroughly before use and retain them for future reference.

The Salter 9193 BK3R is designed for personal weight measurement, offering high precision and ease of use with its clear LCD display and durable stainless steel platform.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

---

- Always use the scale on a firm, flat surface. Using it on soft surfaces like carpet may affect accuracy.
- Do not use the scale on wet or slippery floors. Ensure the scale surface is dry before stepping on it to prevent slipping.
- Do not immerse the scale in water or use abrasive cleaning agents.
- This scale is intended for domestic use only. It is not suitable for commercial or medical purposes.
- Keep the scale away from strong electromagnetic fields.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the scale yourself. Contact customer support if service is required.
- Keep batteries out of reach of children. Dispose of used batteries responsibly.

## 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Batteries (may be pre-installed or included separately)

## 4. PRODUCT FEATURES

---

- **High Capacity:** Measures up to 180 Kilograms (396 lbs / 28 st 5 lb).
- **Precision:** Accurate to 100 Grams (0.2 lb / 1/4 st).
- **Clear Display:** Large LCD display for easy reading.

- **Easy to Clean:** Smooth surface allows for simple maintenance.
- **Step-on Technology:** Instant weight reading upon stepping on the scale.

## 5. SETUP

---

### 5.1. Battery Installation

The scale requires batteries for operation. If batteries are not pre-installed, or if the display shows 'Lo', follow these steps:

1. Turn the scale over to access the battery compartment on the underside.
2. Open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert the required batteries (typically AAA or CR2032, check the compartment for specific type) ensuring correct polarity (+ and -).
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

### 5.2. Initial Placement

For accurate readings, place the scale on a hard, flat, and level surface. Avoid placing it on carpets, rugs, or uneven flooring, as this can significantly affect measurement accuracy.

### 5.3. Unit Selection

Most scales have a unit conversion button (usually on the underside or near the battery compartment) to switch between kilograms (kg), pounds (lb), and stones (st). Press this button to select your preferred unit of measurement before first use or if you wish to change it.

## 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 6.1. Taking a Measurement

1. Ensure the scale is on a hard, flat surface and the desired unit of measurement is selected.
2. Gently step onto the scale with bare feet, centering your weight evenly.
3. Stand still until your weight is displayed on the LCD screen. The reading will typically flash a few times before settling.
4. Step off the scale. The display will hold the reading for a few seconds before automatically turning off.

### 6.2. Zeroing the Scale (Calibration)

The Salter 9193 BK3R typically features automatic zeroing. If you notice inconsistent readings, you can manually re-zero the scale:

1. Place the scale on a hard, flat surface.
2. Lightly tap the center of the scale with your foot to activate it.
3. Wait for '0.0' or '0.00' to appear on the display.
4. The scale is now calibrated and ready for use.

## 7. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

---

### 7.1. Cleaning

The stainless steel platform of your Salter 9193 BK3R scale is designed to be easy to clean.

- Wipe the scale surface with a damp cloth and mild detergent if necessary.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or immerse the scale in water.
- Dry the scale thoroughly after cleaning.

### 7.2. Storage

- Store the scale in a cool, dry place.
- Avoid storing it vertically for extended periods, as this may affect accuracy.
- Do not place heavy objects on the scale when not in use.

### 7.3. Battery Replacement

When the display shows 'Lo' or becomes dim, it's time to replace the batteries. Refer to section 5.1 for battery installation instructions.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
<b>'Lo' displayed</b>	Low battery power.	Replace batteries (refer to Section 5.1).
<b>'Err' displayed</b>	Overload or unstable reading.	Ensure weight does not exceed 180 kg. Step off, wait for '0.0', then re-weigh. Ensure scale is on a flat, stable surface.
<b>Inaccurate readings</b>	Scale on uneven surface, not zeroed, or moved.	Place on a hard, flat surface. Tap to zero ('0.0' displayed) before weighing. Avoid moving the scale between measurements.
<b>No display</b>	Batteries dead or incorrectly installed.	Check battery installation and replace if necessary.
