1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your Thule Yepp Maxi Child Bike Seat. This manual provides essential information for the safe and correct assembly, use, and maintenance of your child bike seat. Please read all instructions carefully before use and retain this manual for future reference.

The Thule Yepp Maxi is a smart and functional rear-mounted child bike seat designed for everyday rides, allowing families to enjoy cycling together. It features a lightweight design, an adjustable 5-point safety harness, and a shock-absorbing seat for your child's comfort and security.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Your child's safety is paramount. Always adhere to the following safety guidelines:

- Ensure the child bike seat is correctly installed according to the instructions.

- Always secure your child with the 5-point harness and childproof buckle before riding.
- Verify that footrests and straps are adjusted to fit your child's feet securely.
- The maximum weight capacity for this seat is 40 lbs (18 kg). Do not exceed this limit.
- This seat is designed for children aged 9 months to 6 years. Consult a pediatrician for children under 1 year old.
- Always ensure your child wears a properly fitted helmet.
- Regularly check all bolts, straps, and components for tightness and wear.
- Do not leave your child unattended in the seat.
- Be aware that the added weight of the child and seat will affect your bicycle's balance and handling. Practice riding with the seat (and child) in a safe area before riding in traffic.
- The seat includes a built-in reflector and a safety light attachment point for added visibility. Ensure these are clear and functional.

3. SETUP & INSTALLATION

The Thule Yepp Maxi child bike seat is designed for easy frame mounting. For detailed visual instructions, please refer to the official installation manual PDF linked in the navigation or consult the Thule website.

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Verify that all parts are present according to the packing list.

3.2 Mounting the Seat Adapter

The seat easily mounts directly to the frame of your bike.

1. Identify the mounting area on your bicycle frame, typically on the seat tube or down tube.
2. Attach the mounting bracket to the bicycle frame. Ensure it is securely fastened and does not interfere with brake cables or other bike components.
3. Tighten all bolts to the manufacturer's specified torque settings.

3.3 Attaching the Child Seat

Once the adapter is securely installed, the child seat can be quickly attached and removed.

1. Align the child seat with the installed adapter.
2. Slide the seat onto the adapter until it clicks securely into place.
3. Engage the safety lock mechanism, often indicated by a key lock, to prevent accidental removal.

Important: Before each ride, always double-check that the seat is firmly attached and locked to the adapter.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Securing Your Child

To ensure your child's safety and comfort:

1. Place your child in the seat.
2. Fasten the 5-point safety harness. Ensure the straps are snug but not too tight, allowing for comfortable movement.
3. Engage the childproof buckle. Listen for a click to confirm it is securely fastened.
4. Adjust the footrests and foot straps to fit your child's feet. This prevents their feet from interfering with the bicycle's wheels.

4.2 Adjusting for Growth

The Thule Yepp Maxi is designed to grow with your child.

- **Harness Height:** The shoulder straps can be adjusted to different height levels to accommodate your child's growth.
- **Footrests:** The footrests are adjustable vertically. Press the release button or lever and slide them to the appropriate height for your child's legs.
- **Foot Straps:** The foot straps have multiple holes to adjust tightness around your child's feet.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safety of your Thule Yepp Maxi Child Bike Seat.

- **Cleaning:** The water-repellent material is easy to clean. Use mild soap and water with a soft cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all parts for signs of wear, damage, or corrosion. Pay close attention to the harness, buckles, footrests, and mounting hardware.
- **Fasteners:** Ensure all bolts and screws are tight. Do not overtighten.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the seat in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures, to prevent material degradation.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Seat feels wobbly or loose.	Mounting adapter not securely fastened or seat not fully engaged.	Ensure all mounting bolts are tightened. Re-attach the seat, ensuring it clicks into place and the safety lock is engaged.
Harness straps are too tight or too loose.	Incorrect harness adjustment.	Adjust the shoulder strap height and strap length for a snug, comfortable fit.
Child's feet are touching the wheel.	Footrests are too low or foot straps are not used.	Adjust footrests to a higher position. Secure child's feet with the foot straps.
Difficulty attaching/detaching seat.	Safety lock engaged or misalignment.	Ensure the safety lock is disengaged. Check for any obstructions or misalignment during attachment/detachment.



