Yamaha RAV536 Remote Control (ZP601100) Instruction Manual

Official instruction manual for the Yamaha RAV536 OEM A/V Receiver Remote Control.

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper use and care of your Yamaha RAV536 (Part # ZP601100) OEM remote control. This remote is designed to operate specific Yamaha A/V receiver models, ensuring seamless control over your audio and video system. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your remote control.

2. COMPATIBLE MODELS

The Yamaha RAV536 (ZP601100) remote control is specifically designed for use with the following Yamaha A/V receiver models:

- TSR-7790
- RX-V679BL

- HTR-6068
- TSR-7790BL
- RX-A750
- RX-V679
- RX-V779

Important: This is an OEM remote control and is not universal. It is intended to replace the original remote supplied with the listed models only. Compatibility with other models is not guaranteed.

3. SETUP: BATTERY INSTALLATION

To begin using your Yamaha RAV536 remote control, you must install batteries. The remote requires two (2) AAA batteries (not included).

1. **Open the Battery Compartment:** Locate the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote control. Slide the cover downwards or press the latch and lift to open.
2. **Insert Batteries:** Insert two new AAA batteries into the compartment. Ensure that the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals of the batteries align correctly with the polarity indicators inside the compartment. Incorrect installation can prevent the remote from functioning.
3. **Close the Battery Compartment:** Replace the battery compartment cover by sliding it back into place until it clicks securely.

Note: Always use new batteries for optimal performance. Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries, as this can lead to leakage or malfunction.

4. OPERATION

Once batteries are installed, the Yamaha RAV536 remote control is ready for use with your compatible Yamaha A/V receiver. No additional programming is typically required for OEM remotes.

- **Pointing the Remote:** Point the remote control directly towards the infrared (IR) sensor on your Yamaha A/V receiver. Obstructions between the remote and the receiver can block the signal.
- **Button Functions:** Each button on the remote corresponds to a specific function on your A/V receiver (e.g., Power, Volume, Input Selection, Menu Navigation). Refer to the owner's manual of your specific Yamaha A/V receiver model for a detailed explanation of each button's function and how to operate your system.
- **Range:** The remote operates effectively within a range of approximately 10 meters (33 feet) from the receiver, provided there are no significant obstructions.

For advanced features and specific operational procedures, consult the comprehensive owner's manual that came with your Yamaha A/V receiver.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and reliable performance of your remote control.

- **Battery Replacement:** Replace batteries when the remote's response becomes sluggish or stops working. Always replace both batteries simultaneously with new ones of the same type (AAA).
- **Cleaning:** To clean the remote, gently wipe it with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Avoid using harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive materials, as these can damage the remote's surface or internal components.

- **Storage:** If the remote will not be used for an extended period, remove the batteries to prevent potential leakage and damage. Store the remote in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Avoid Drops and Impacts:** Protect the remote from physical shocks, drops, and impacts, which can damage internal circuitry.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your Yamaha RAV536 remote control, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

1. Remote Not Responding:

- Check if the batteries are inserted correctly, observing polarity (+/-).
- Replace old batteries with new AAA batteries.
- Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote's IR emitter and the receiver's IR sensor.
- Verify that you are pointing the remote directly at the receiver.

2. Limited Range or Intermittent Operation:

- Replace batteries with new ones.
- Ensure the remote's IR emitter and the receiver's IR sensor are clean and free from dust or smudges.
- Reduce the distance between the remote and the receiver.
- Check for strong light sources (e.g., direct sunlight, fluorescent lights) that might interfere with the IR signal.

3. Specific Functions Not Working:

- Confirm that your A/V receiver is powered on and functioning correctly.
- Refer to your A/V receiver's owner's manual to ensure you are using the correct buttons for the desired functions.

If the problem persists after trying these steps, contact Yamaha customer support or refer to your receiver's manual for further assistance.
