# edding 4500 Textile Marker User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

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The edding 4500 Textile Marker set provides a versatile solution for decorating and personalizing light-colored fabrics. These markers are designed to deliver vibrant, permanent, and wash-resistant results, making them ideal for various textile projects, from custom apparel to home decor items. This manual will guide you through the proper use and care of your edding textile markers to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your creations.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

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### 2.1 Package Contents

- 5 edding 4500 Textile Markers (Black, Red, Blue, Green, Yellow)

## 2.2 Key Features

- Suitable for almost all light-colored fabrics, including cotton, silk, and linen.
- Results are wash-resistant up to 60 °C after heat-fixing.
- Ink is extremely lightfast, low-odor, and quick-drying.
- Round nib with a line size of 2-3 mm, ideal for coloring and broader strokes.
- Cap can be placed on the end of the marker barrel during use.

## 3. SETUP AND PREPARATION

### 3.1 Fabric Preparation

Before applying the markers, ensure your fabric is clean and dry. For best results and to prevent ink from bleeding through to the other side of the fabric or surface below, place a piece of cardboard or thick paper underneath the area you intend to decorate. If working on a larger piece of fabric, securing it with double-sided tape to a flat, stable surface can prevent shifting during application.

### 3.2 Marker Preparation

Before first use or if the marker has not been used for a while, gently shake the marker with the cap on. Then, press the nib down several times on a scrap piece of paper until the ink flows consistently. This primes the nib for smooth application.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

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### 4.1 Application Steps

1. **Design Your Artwork:** Plan your design on paper first, or lightly sketch it onto the fabric with a pencil if desired.
2. **Outline:** Begin by drawing the outlines of your design. Allow the outlines to dry completely before proceeding to fill in colors.
3. **Fill In Colors:** Once the outlines are dry, carefully fill in the desired areas with color. For best results, apply even pressure and work in small sections.

## 4.2 Heat Fixing

To ensure the durability and wash-resistance of your textile artwork, heat-fix the design after the ink has completely dried. This can be done by ironing the fabric without steam. Place a thin cloth or baking paper over the decorated area and iron for approximately 1-2 minutes at a medium temperature (corresponding to cotton settings). This process permanently sets the ink into the fabric fibers.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### 5.1 Storage

For optimal ink flow and to prevent drying out, always store your edding textile markers horizontally. Ensure the caps are securely placed on the markers when not in use.

### 5.2 Cleaning

Once heat-fixed, your decorated textiles can be washed at temperatures up to 60 °C. Avoid using harsh detergents or bleach, which may affect the vibrancy of the colors over time. For best results, wash decorated items inside out.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Ink not flowing smoothly.	Marker nib is dry or not primed.	Shake the marker well and press the nib down on a scrap piece of paper until ink flows.
Colors fading after washing.	Design was not properly heat-fixed.	Ensure the design is completely dry, then heat-fix by ironing without steam for 1-2 minutes at a medium temperature.
Ink bleeding through fabric.	No protective layer underneath fabric.	Always place cardboard or thick paper under the fabric to prevent bleed-through.
