1. Introduction

The Airfrex AF25 Bluetooth receiver is a wireless audio adapter designed for the Bose QuietComfort 25 Active Noise Cancellation Headphone. This adapter enables Bluetooth connectivity for the Bose QC25, allowing wireless connection to phones, tablets, or laptops. This manual provides instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your Airfrex AF25 adapter.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND FEATURES

The Airfrex AF25 adapter converts your wired Bose QC25 headphones into a wireless Bluetooth headset, offering enhanced mobility and convenience.

5. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

5.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the Airfrex AF25 adapter. Connect the provided USB charging cable to the adapter's charging port and to a standard USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, wall adapter). The LED indicator will show charging status.

5.2 Connecting to Bose QC25 Headphones

- 1. Locate the audio input jack on your Bose QuietComfort 25 headphones.
- 2. Carefully insert the 2.5mm audio jack of the Airfrex AF25 adapter into the headphone's audio input. Ensure it is fully seated.



6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Power On/Off

- Power On: Press and hold the multi-function button until the LED indicator lights up.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the multi-function button until the LED indicator turns off. The adapter also features an automatic shutdown function to save power.

6.2 Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Ensure the adapter is powered off.
- 2. Press and hold the multi-function button for approximately 5-7 seconds until the LED indicator flashes blue and red alternately. This indicates pairing mode.
- 3. On your smartphone, tablet, or other Bluetooth-enabled device, enable Bluetooth and search for new devices.
- 4. Select "Airfrex AF25" from the list of available devices.
- 5. Once paired, the LED indicator on the adapter will flash blue periodically.

6.3 Controls

The integrated multi-function button allows control over various functions:

- Play/Pause: Short press the multi-function button.
- Answer/End Call: Short press the multi-function button during an incoming call or an active
 call.
- Reject Call: Press and hold the multi-function button for 2 seconds during an incoming call.
- Activate Voice Assistant: Double-press the multi-function button (if supported by your connected device).
- Bass Enhancement: (Specific instruction for this feature is not detailed in provided data, typically a double-press or long-press of a specific button if available, or automatically managed by the chipset.)

6.4 Charging the Adapter

When the battery is low, the LED indicator may flash red. Connect the adapter to a USB power source using the provided USB cable. The LED will typically be solid red during charging and turn off or change color when fully charged.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Adapter does not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the adapter fully.
Cannot pair with device.	Adapter not in pairing mode; Bluetooth off on device; device too far.	Ensure adapter is in pairing mode (flashing blue/red). Turn on Bluetooth on your device. Move device closer to adapter (within 10m).
No sound or poor sound quality.	Adapter not fully inserted into headphones; low battery; interference.	Ensure the 2.5mm jack is fully inserted into the QC25 headphones. Charge the adapter. Move away from sources of strong electromagnetic interference.
Short battery life.	Adapter not fully charged; high volume usage.	Ensure adapter is fully charged before use. Reduce listening volume if possible.
