## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Don't Die In The Woods (DDITW) Ultralight Survival Tent is designed to provide emergency shelter for two adults. Constructed from durable HeatFlex mylar, it offers protection against various weather conditions and helps retain body heat. This compact and reusable shelter is an essential component for outdoor adventures and emergency preparedness kits.

### Key Features:

- **HeatFlex Mylar:** Extra thick, tear-resistant, reduced noise, and reusable material.
- **Heat Reflective:** NASA-designed mylar reflects up to 90% of body heat.
- **Waterproof & Windproof:** Provides protection from rain, wind, and snow.
- **Compact & Ultralight:** Weighs only 8.5 ounces and packs down small for easy transport.
- **425-lb Paracord:** Includes 20 feet of nylon-core paracord for setup.
- **Reinforced Seams:** Extra wide tape seams enhance durability and protection.

## 2. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

The DDITW Survival Tent is designed for quick and easy deployment in emergency situations. Follow these steps for proper setup:

1. **Unpack the Tent:** Remove the tent and the included 20-foot paracord from the storage sack.
2. **Locate Anchor Points:** Find two sturdy trees or bushes approximately 15-20 feet apart.
3. **Thread the Paracord:** Run the entire length of the paracord through the tube of the mylar tent.
4. **Secure the Ridge Line:** Tie one end of the paracord securely to one tree/bush. Pull the tent taut and tie the other end of the paracord to the second tree/bush, creating a ridge line for the tent.
5. **Anchor the Corners:** Spread the base of the tent out. Use heavy rocks, logs, or other available gear to anchor the four corners of the tent to the ground. This will help maintain its shape and stability.
6. **Enter the Shelter:** Once secured, you can climb inside for protection.

**Alternative Use (Emergency Sleeping Bag/Bivy Sack):** If no suitable anchor points (trees/bushes) are available, the 80 square feet of mylar can be used as an emergency sleeping bag or bivy sack. Simply wrap yourself in the mylar for warmth and protection.

## 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The DDITW Survival Tent is designed to provide thermal regulation in various conditions:

- **Cold Weather Use:** The silver interior of the mylar reflects up to 90% of your body heat back to you, helping to conserve warmth. Ensure the silver side faces inwards for maximum heat retention.
- **Hot Weather Use:** In hot conditions, turn the tent inside out so the silver side faces outwards. This will reflect heat away from the tent, helping to keep the interior cooler.
- **Water Protection:** The tent's material is waterproof, offering protection from rain and snow.
- **Wind Protection:** When properly anchored, the tent provides a barrier against wind.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

The DDITW Survival Tent is designed for reusability. Proper care will extend its lifespan:

- **Cleaning:** If the tent becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could damage the mylar.
- **Drying:** Ensure the tent is completely dry before repacking to prevent mildew or material degradation.
- **Repacking:** Carefully fold or roll the tent back into its original compact form. Store the paracord with the tent in the provided nylon storage sack.
- **Storage:** Store the tent in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

While the DDITW Survival Tent is robust, here are solutions for common concerns:

- **Tears or Punctures:** Although tear-resistant, extreme conditions or sharp objects can cause damage. Small tears can often be repaired with strong, waterproof tape (not included).
- **Difficulty Setting Up:** Ensure the paracord is fully threaded through the tent and tied securely to stable anchor points. Adjust tension as needed. If no trees are available, remember the bivy sack alternative.
- **Insufficient Warmth:** Verify the silver side of the mylar is facing inwards. Ensure the tent is sealed as much as possible at the ends to minimize heat loss. Consider adding an emergency blanket or bivy sack inside for additional insulation.
- **Condensation Inside:** In humid conditions, condensation can occur. Ensure adequate ventilation if possible without compromising warmth or protection from elements.
