1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper installation and use of your SatelliteSale DIRECTV Universal High Speed 12 FT HDMI Cable. This cable is designed to transmit high-quality digital audio and video signals between compatible devices. It features 100% oxygen-free copper conductors and gold-plated contacts for reliable signal transfer. The cable is triple-shielded to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI), ensuring a clear signal.

2. PRODUCT FEATURES

- **HDMI 2.0 Specification:** Each cable meets HDMI 2.0 specifications, supporting advanced features.
- **Internet Connection Sharing:** Supports sharing an internet connection among multiple devices without the need for a separate Ethernet cable.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to properly connect your HDMI cable:

1. **Identify Ports:** Locate the HDMI output port on your source device (e.g., Blu-ray player, gaming console, PC, Apple TV, Roku, cable/satellite box) and the HDMI input port on your display device (e.g., Ultra HD 4K TV, A/V receiver, projector).
2. **Connect Cable:** Carefully insert one end of the HDMI cable into the HDMI output port of your source device.
3. **Connect to Display:** Insert the other end of the HDMI cable into an available HDMI input port on your display device. Ensure both connections are secure.
4. **Power On Devices:** Turn on both your source device and your display device.

Note: Ensure that the HDMI ports are clean and free from obstructions before connecting the cable.

4. OPERATION

Once the cable is connected, operate your devices as follows:

1. **Select Input:** On your display device (TV, projector), use the remote control to select the correct HDMI input source that corresponds to the port where you connected the cable. For example, if you connected to HDMI 1, select HDMI 1 as the input.
2. **Verify Signal:** Confirm that the audio and video signals are being transmitted correctly. You should see the content from your source device on your display.
3. **Adjust Settings:** If necessary, adjust the display settings on your source device or display device to optimize picture and sound quality (e.g., resolution, aspect ratio, audio output).

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues, refer to the following troubleshooting tips:

- **No Picture or Sound:**
 - Ensure both ends of the HDMI cable are securely connected.
 - Verify that the correct HDMI input source is selected on your display device.
 - Try connecting the cable to a different HDMI port on your display device.
 - Test the cable with another source device or display device if available, to rule out a device-specific issue.
 - Restart both the source and display devices.
- **Poor Picture Quality (Flickering, Distortion):**
 - Check for any kinks or damage to the HDMI cable.
 - Ensure the cable is not running near strong electromagnetic interference sources.
 - Reduce the resolution output from your source device to see if the issue persists.
- **No Audio:**
 - Confirm that the audio output settings on your source device are correctly configured for HDMI.

- Check the volume levels on both your source and display devices.
- If using an A/V receiver, ensure it is set to the correct input and audio mode.
