Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Toshiba 43LF621U19 43-inch Smart 4K UHD Fire TV. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the television and retain it for future reference. This television integrates the Fire TV experience, offering access to streaming content and live over-the-air TV.

What's in the Box

Verify that all components are present before proceeding with setup:

- Toshiba 43LF621U19 43-inch Smart 4K UHD Fire TV
- Voice Remote with Alexa
- TV Stand (2 pieces)
- Power Cord
- AAA Batteries (2) for remote
- Quick Setup Guide
- Safety Sheet

Setup

1. Physical Setup (Attaching the Stand)

To ensure stability, attach the included stand to the television. Place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches. Align the stand pieces with the screw holes on the bottom of the TV and secure them with the provided screws. Alternatively, the TV can be wall-mounted using a VESA-compatible mount (sold separately).

2. Initial Power On & Network Connection

1. Connect the power cord to the TV and then to a power outlet.
2. Insert the AAA batteries into the Voice Remote with Alexa.
3. Press the power button on the remote to turn on the TV.
4. Follow the on-screen instructions to select your language and connect to your Wi-Fi network. You may need to enter your Wi-Fi password.
5. The TV will check for and install any available software updates.

3. Account Setup (Fire TV/Alexa)

After network connection, you will be prompted to sign in with your Amazon account. This is necessary to access Fire TV features, streaming apps, and Alexa voice control. If you do not have an Amazon account, you can create one during this step.

Operating Instructions

1. Remote Control Overview

The Voice Remote with Alexa provides intuitive control over your TV and Fire TV experience. Key buttons include:

- **Power:** Turns the TV on/off.
- **Alexa Voice Button:** Press and hold to activate Alexa for voice commands.
- **Navigation Ring:** Use to move through menus and select items.
- **Home:** Returns to the Fire TV home screen.
- **Back:** Returns to the previous screen.
- **Volume Up/Down:** Adjusts TV volume.
- **Mute:** Mutes/unmutes TV audio.
- **App Shortcut Buttons:** Direct access to popular streaming services (e.g., Prime Video, Netflix).

2. Navigating the Fire TV Interface

The Fire TV home screen provides a centralized hub for all your entertainment. Use the navigation ring on your remote to browse through recommended content, installed apps, and live TV options. The interface is designed for easy access to movies, TV shows, and various streaming services.

3. Streaming Content

Access a wide range of streaming services such as Prime Video, Netflix, YouTube, Hulu, and more directly from the home screen. Select an app to launch it and begin streaming. Ensure a stable internet connection for optimal performance.

4. Live TV (Antenna)

To watch live over-the-air TV, connect an HD antenna (sold separately) to the ANT/CABLE input on the back of the TV. Navigate to the 'Live' tab on the Fire TV interface and perform a channel scan to find available local channels.

5. Voice Control with Alexa

Press and hold the Alexa voice button on your remote and speak your command. You can use Alexa to:

- Launch apps (e.g., "Open Netflix")

- Search for titles (e.g., "Find action movies")
- Control playback (e.g., "Pause", "Rewind 30 seconds")
- Switch inputs (e.g., "Switch to HDMI 1")
- Control smart home devices (if compatible and linked to your Alexa account)

6. Connecting External Devices

The TV features multiple input ports for connecting external devices:

- **HDMI:** Connect Blu-ray players, game consoles, cable/satellite boxes.
- **USB:** Connect USB drives for media playback.
- **Ethernet (LAN):** For a wired internet connection.
- **Optical Digital Audio Out:** For connecting to a soundbar or audio receiver.

Maintenance

1. Cleaning

To clean the screen, gently wipe it with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-cleaning solution specifically designed for electronics. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or direct spraying onto the screen.

For the TV casing, use a soft, dry cloth. Do not allow liquids to enter the ventilation openings.

2. Software Updates

Your Fire TV automatically receives software updates over the air to enhance features and improve performance.

Ensure your TV is connected to the internet to receive these updates. You can manually check for updates in the TV's settings menu.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your Toshiba Fire TV, refer to the following common solutions:

Issue	Possible Solution
No Power	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the TV and a working electrical outlet. Try a different outlet.
No Picture, but Sound is Present	Check the input source. Ensure external devices are powered on and connected correctly. Try restarting the TV.
No Sound, but Picture is Present	Check the volume level and ensure the TV is not muted. Verify external audio devices are connected and configured correctly.
Remote Not Responding	Replace the batteries in the remote. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV. Re-pair the remote if necessary (hold Home button for 10 seconds).
Wi-Fi Connection Issues	Restart your router and modem. Reconnect to the Wi-Fi network via the TV settings. Ensure the TV is within range of the router.
Picture Glitches/Distortion	Check all cable connections. Try a different input source. If using an antenna, check its connection and position. Perform a factory reset if the issue persists.
