PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The OER 9624995 Windshield Glass Support is a reproduction component designed for 1970-1981 Camaro models. This part is crucial for properly positioning and supporting the vehicle's windshield glass. It is constructed from stamped galvanized steel and features a rubber-coated foot for secure placement and protection. Each support includes an installation screw. Two units are typically required for a complete installation.

INSTALLATION GUIDE

MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Windshield Rattle or Movement:**
 - *Cause:* Loose installation screw or worn rubber foot.
 - *Solution:* Check and tighten the installation screw. If the rubber foot is significantly worn or damaged, the support may need replacement.
- **Visible Damage to Support:**
 - *Cause:* Impact, age, or environmental exposure.
 - *Solution:* If the galvanized steel is bent or corroded, or the rubber is cracked or missing, the support should be replaced to ensure proper windshield stability.
- **Difficulty During Installation:**
 - *Cause:* Incorrect part for vehicle model, existing vehicle damage, or improper alignment.
 - *Solution:* Verify the part number matches your vehicle's requirements. Inspect the vehicle's mounting area for any damage. Seek professional assistance if alignment issues persist.
