INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the safe and efficient operation and maintenance of your Lasko XtraAir T48331 48-inch Tower Fan. Please read all instructions carefully before use and retain this manual for future reference.

SETUP

The Lasko XtraAir T48331 tower fan is designed for easy assembly and placement. Follow these steps to set up your fan:

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure all parts are present before proceeding.
2. **Base Assembly:** Attach the fan base securely according to the instructions provided in the separate assembly guide (if applicable).
3. **Placement:** Position the fan on a firm, level surface. The slim design allows for placement in various indoor spaces, such as bedrooms or offices. Utilize the integrated carry handle for convenient transport.
4. **Power Connection:** Plug the fan into a standard 120 Volt NEMA 5-15 electrical outlet. Ensure the power cord is not obstructed or pinched.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Lasko XtraAir T48331 tower fan offers multiple settings for personalized comfort. Controls are accessible via the top panel or the included remote control.

Control Panel & Remote Functions:

- **Power Button (⏻):** Press to turn the fan ON or OFF.
- **Speed Settings:** The fan features 4 quiet speed options. Press the speed button to cycle through the available settings (1, 2, 3, 4).

- **Oscillation ():** Activate widespread oscillation to distribute air throughout the room. Press the oscillation button to turn this feature ON or OFF.
- **Timer ():** Set the electronic timer for automatic shut-off after 1, 2, 4, or 8 hours. Press the timer button to select the desired duration.
- **Ionizer (ION):** Engage the fresh air ionizer to enhance air purification and filtration, improving indoor air quality. Press the ionizer button to activate or deactivate.

The compact remote control provides the convenience of adjusting fan settings from a distance. It includes buttons for power, speed, oscillation, timer, and ionizer functions. Please note that batteries for the remote control are not included.

MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning is crucial for maintaining the performance, safety, and lifespan of your Lasko XtraAir T48331 tower

fan. It is recommended to clean your fan at least twice per month.

Cleaning Procedure:

1. **Disconnect Power:** Always unplug the fan from the electrical outlet before cleaning.
2. **Identify Vents:** Locate the intake vents (typically at the back) and exhaust vents (at the front) of the fan.
3. **Vacuum Cleaning:** Use a vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment to gently clean the outside of both the front exhaust grill and the rear intake vents. This helps remove accumulated dust and debris.
4. **Compressed Air (Optional):** If vacuuming does not completely remove all dust, use a can of compressed air to blow short bursts of air into the front exhaust vent. This can dislodge stubborn dust from internal components. After using compressed air, re-vacuum the rear intake vent to collect any dislodged dust.
5. **Exterior Wipe-Down:** Wipe the exterior surfaces of the fan with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or allow water to drip into the interior of the fan.

Important: Your Lasko tower fan is designed not to be opened. Opening the unit can lead to safety concerns and will void the warranty.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan runs for a brief time, then unexpectedly shuts off.	Build-up of dust on the fan's internal components or vents.	Perform the regular cleaning steps outlined in the "Maintenance" section. Ensure all intake and exhaust vents are clear of dust and debris.
