SETUP

1. **Charge the Presenter:** Before first use, connect the presenter to a USB power source using the provided USB charging cable. A full charge takes approximately 1-2 hours. The indicator light will change to show charging status.
2. **Insert USB Receiver:** Locate the USB receiver stored magnetically within the presenter. Plug the


receiver into an available USB-A or USB-C port on your computer.

3. **Power On:** Turn on the presenter using the ON/OFF switch, usually located on the side.
4. **Automatic Connection:** The presenter should automatically connect to your computer. No additional drivers or software are typically required.



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Familiarize yourself with the buttons on your DinoFire presentation remote:

- **Green Laser Pointer Button:** Press and hold to activate the green laser pointer. Release to turn off.
- **Page Up/Forward Button (▲):** Press to advance to the next slide or page in your presentation.
- **Page Down/Backward Button (▼):** Press to go back to the previous slide or page.
- **Hyperlink Button:** Used to activate hyperlinks within your presentation.
- **Switch Windows Button:** Allows you to switch between open applications or windows on your computer.
- **Volume Control Buttons (+/-):** Adjust the system volume up or down.

CHARGING AND BATTERY LIFE

To charge, connect the included USB cable to the presenter and a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, wall adapter). A full charge typically takes 1-2 hours and provides several weeks of usage, depending on frequency of use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Presenter not responding.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ensure the presenter is powered on.◦ Check if the USB receiver is securely plugged into the computer.◦ Try plugging the receiver into a different USB port.◦ Recharge the presenter if the battery is low.◦ Restart your computer.
Laser pointer is dim or not working.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ensure the presenter is fully charged.◦ Make sure you are pressing and holding the laser button.

Problem	Possible Solution
Limited wireless range.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Ensure there are no major obstructions between the presenter and the receiver. ◦ Avoid strong electromagnetic interference from other devices. ◦ Ensure the receiver is not plugged into a USB hub that is far from the computer.
Buttons not functioning correctly in specific software.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Verify the software is supported (e.g., PowerPoint, Keynote). ◦ Ensure the software window is active and in presentation mode. ◦ Some software may require specific settings or add-ins for full functionality.


