2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation of the presser foot is crucial for optimal performance and to prevent damage to your sewing machine or the foot itself. Always ensure your sewing machine is turned off and unplugged before attempting any installation or removal of parts.

Installation Steps:

- 1. Prepare Machine:** Turn off and unplug your sewing machine. Raise the needle to its highest position and lift the presser foot lever.
- 2. Remove Old Foot (if applicable):** Loosen the screw that holds the current presser foot in place. Carefully remove the old presser foot.
- 3. Attach New Foot:** Align the Cutex Presser Foot #B1524-012-0A0 with the presser foot bar. Ensure the slot on the presser foot aligns with the screw.
- 4. Secure Foot:** Tighten the screw firmly to secure the presser foot in place. Do not overtighten.
- 5. Test Movement:** Lower the presser foot lever and gently move the foot to ensure it is securely attached and moves freely without obstruction.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Cutex Presser Foot #B1524-012-0A0 is designed for general sewing applications on light to medium weight fabrics. Its hinged design is particularly beneficial for navigating challenging areas.

Usage Tips:

- **General Sewing:** Use for standard straight stitching on various fabric types.
- **Bulky Seams:** The hinged mechanism allows the foot to flex and ride smoothly over bulky seams, preventing skipped stitches or uneven feeding. This is especially useful when performing reverse stitching over such areas.
- **Uneven Surfaces:** When sewing materials with varying thicknesses or textures, the hinged foot adapts to maintain consistent pressure, aiding in smooth fabric feeding.
- **Needle Clearance:** Always ensure the needle passes cleanly through the center opening of the presser foot to avoid needle breakage or damage to the foot.

Adjust tension and stitch length according to your fabric and thread type, as you would with any standard sewing operation.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the lifespan of your presser foot and ensure continued optimal performance.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically wipe the presser foot with a soft, dry cloth to remove lint, dust, and fabric fibers. For stubborn residue, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the foot for any signs of wear, bending, or damage. Ensure the hinged mechanism moves freely.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the presser foot in a clean, dry place to prevent corrosion or damage.

Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials for cleaning, as these can damage the metal finish.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Presser foot does not fit.	Incorrect shank type or machine model.	Verify your sewing machine's shank system (high shank, 1 inch from screw to foot bottom) and compatibility with the listed Juki models.
Needle hits the presser foot.	Foot not properly aligned or secured; bent needle.	Re-attach the presser foot, ensuring it is centered and tightened. Replace the needle if it is bent.
Fabric not feeding smoothly.	Foot not fully lowered; feed dogs not engaged; excessive lint under foot.	Ensure the presser foot lever is fully lowered. Check feed dog engagement. Clean any lint or debris from around the feed dogs and under the presser foot.
