INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Mornwell Water Flosser. This device is designed to provide effective oral hygiene by using a powerful water jet to clean between teeth and below the gumline, where traditional brushing and flossing may not reach. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use to ensure safe and optimal operation.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the main parts of your Mornwell Water Flosser:

- Main Unit: Contains the motor, battery, and control buttons.
- Water Tank: Detachable reservoir for water.
- **Nozzle Tips:** Various tips for different cleaning needs (e.g., standard, periodontal, orthodontic).
- USB Charging Cable: For recharging the internal battery.

SETUP AND FIRST USE

1. Charge the Device: Before first use, fully charge the water flosser. Connect the USB charging cable to the device

- and a suitable USB power adapter (not included). The indicator light will show charging status. A full charge takes approximately 8 hours and provides up to 2 weeks of use.
- 2. Attach Nozzle Tip: Insert the desired nozzle tip into the hole at the top of the main unit until it clicks into place.
- 3. **Fill Water Tank:** Detach the water tank by sliding it down. Fill the 300ml tank with lukewarm water. You can also add mouthwash if desired. Reattach the tank securely.
- 4. **Prime the Unit (First Use Only):** Point the nozzle into a sink. Turn on the device to allow water to flow through until a steady stream is produced. This removes any air from the system.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Mornwell Water Flosser features 3 cleaning modes to suit various oral care needs:

- Normal Mode (60-90 PSI): For daily cleaning and experienced users. Provides a strong water pulse for effective plaque removal.
- Soft Mode (40-60 PSI): Ideal for first-time users, sensitive teeth, and delicate gums. Offers a gentle yet effective cleaning.
- Pulse Mode (40-80 PSI): Designed to massage gums and stimulate blood circulation, promoting stronger gums.

How to Use:

- 1. Select your desired cleaning mode by pressing the "Mode" button.
- 2. Lean over a sink and place the nozzle tip into your mouth, aiming it at your gumline at a 90-degree angle.

- 3. Press the "On/Off" button to start the water flow.
- 4. Guide the water stream along your gumline, pausing briefly between teeth. Allow the water to flow into the sink.
- 5. The device features a 2-minute auto-timer to ensure optimal cleaning time and prevent over-exposure. It will automatically shut off after 120 seconds.
- 6. After use, turn off the device and empty any remaining water from the tank.




Figure 5: Users demonstrating the deep cleaning action of the water flosser.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Mornwell Water Flosser.

- 1. After Each Use: Empty any remaining water from the tank. Rinse the water tank thoroughly with clean water.
- 2. **Cleaning the Main Unit:** Wipe the exterior of the main unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the unit in water.
- 3. Cleaning Nozzle Tips: Remove the nozzle tip and rinse it under running water. For deeper cleaning, you can soak the tips in a solution of 2 parts water to 1 part white vinegar for 5-10 minutes, then rinse thoroughly. Replace nozzle tips every 3-6 months, or sooner if they become worn.
- 4. **Drying and Storage:** Allow all parts to air dry completely before reassembling and storing. Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not turn on.	Low battery or not charged.	Charge the device fully (approx. 8 hours).
Weak water pressure.	Water tank empty or low. Nozzle tip clogged. Air in the system.	Refill water tank. Clean nozzle tip. Prime the unit by running it into a sink until steady flow.
Water leaks from the unit.	Water tank not securely attached. Nozzle tip not fully inserted.	Ensure water tank is clicked into place. Ensure nozzle tip is fully inserted until it clicks.
Device stops unexpectedly.	2-minute auto-timer activated. Low battery.	This is normal operation for the auto-timer. Recharge the device if battery is low.
