## 1. Introduction

The iFLYTEK Easy Trans 2.0 is an advanced portable electronic language translator designed to facilitate communication across language barriers. Utilizing cutting-edge artificial intelligence technologies, this device offers real-time translation for various scenarios, including travel, business, and learning. It supports multiple translation modes and connectivity options to ensure reliable performance.

# 2. KEY FEATURES

- Multilingual Translation: Supports instant translation between Chinese and 33 other languages, including English, Japanese, Korean, French, Spanish, German, Russian, Thai, Indonesian, Italian, Portuguese, Vietnamese, Greek, Malay, Czech, Danish, Norwegian, Dutch, Swedish, Turkish, Arabic, Finnish, Hebrew, Indo, Croatian, Hungarian, Polish, Romanian, Slovak, Tamil, Bulgarian, Catalan, and Slovenian
- Offline Translation: Equipped with a Neural Machine Translation (NMT) offline engine, providing translation capabilities in environments without internet access. Offline translation currently supports Chinese-English, English-Chinese, Chinese-Russian, Russian-Chinese, Chinese-Japanese, Japanese-Chinese, Chinese-Korean, and Korean-Chinese.
- **Dialect Translation:** Advanced dialect recognition technology allows for instant translation of dialects and non-standard Mandarin. Currently supports Cantonese, Sichuan dialect, Northeast dialect, and Henan dialect.
- Photo Translation: Optimized for Optical Character Recognition (OCR) of handwritten and printed text, ideal for foreign signs, menus, and product labels. Supports photo translation in 12 languages online (Chinese to English, Japanese, Korean, French, Spanish, German, Russian, Italian, Portuguese, Thai, Arabic, and vice versa) and Chinese to English offline.
- Connectivity: Supports Wi-Fi, 4G SIM cards, and virtual cards for flexible internet access.

## 3. DEVICE OVERVIEW

## 3.1 Physical Buttons and Ports

- **Power Button:** Located on the side (refer to Figure 2). Press and hold to power on/off. Short press to wake/sleep the screen.
- **Translation Buttons:** Two main buttons on the front (refer to Figure 1), typically labeled "ABC" and " " (Chinese), used for initiating voice translation in different languages.
- **SOS Button:** Located on the back (refer to Figure 3). Functionality may vary; typically used for emergency contact or assistance.
- Charging Port: Usually a USB-C or Micro-USB port for charging the device.
- **SIM Card Slot:** For inserting a 4G SIM card (if applicable to your model).

# 4. SETUP GUIDE

## 4.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the device. Connect the provided charging cable to the device's charging port and a compatible 5V power adapter. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging status.

#### 4.2 Powering On/Off

- To Power On: Press and hold the Power button (Figure 2) until the screen illuminates and the device starts up.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until a power-off option appears on the screen. Select "Power Off" to shut down the device.
- Screen On/Off: A short press of the Power button will turn the screen on or off without powering down
  the device.

#### **4.3 Network Connection**

For online translation features, the device requires an internet connection.

#### • Wi-Fi Connection:

- 1. Go to "Settings" on the device.
- 2. Select "Wi-Fi" and turn it on.
- 3. Choose your desired Wi-Fi network from the list.
- 4. Enter the password if prompted and connect.

#### • 4G SIM Card:

- 1. Insert a compatible 4G SIM card into the designated slot (refer to device diagram for location).
- 2. Ensure mobile data is enabled in the device settings.
- **Virtual Card:** The device may support virtual eSIM services. Refer to the device's on-screen instructions or specific documentation for activating virtual card services.

#### 4.4 Language Selection

Upon initial setup or in the settings menu, select your preferred interface language and the primary translation languages.

### 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### **5.1 Voice Translation (Dialogue Mode)**

This is the primary function for real-time spoken language translation.

- 1. Ensure the device is connected to the internet (for online translation) or has offline language packs installed.
- 2. On the main screen, select the two languages for translation (e.g., Chinese to English).
- 3. One person speaks into the device while holding down their designated translation button (e.g., "ABC" for English, " " for Chinese).
- 4. Release the button after speaking. The device will translate and speak the translation aloud, and display it on the screen.
- 5. The other person then responds by holding down their designated button.




Figure 4: Illustrates two individuals using the iFLYTEK Easy Trans 2.0 for a conversation, demonstrating its use in a travel or business setting.

## **5.2 Photo Translation**

Use the device's camera to translate text from images.

- 1. Navigate to the "Photo Translation" mode on the device.
- 2. Position the camera over the text you wish to translate (e.g., a sign, menu, or document).
- 3. Tap the screen or press a designated button to capture the image.
- 4. The device will process the image and display the translated text.




Figure 9: A person using the iFLYTEK Easy Trans 2.0 to translate text from a large map, demonstrating the photo translation feature.

# **5.3 Offline Translation Mode**

When internet access is unavailable, the device can perform offline translation for supported language pairs.

- Ensure the necessary offline language packs have been downloaded previously while connected to the internet.
- The device will automatically switch to offline mode if no internet connection is detected and an offline pack is available for the selected languages.
- Proceed with voice translation as described in Section 5.1.

Note: Offline translation accuracy may vary compared to online translation and is limited to specific language pairs (Chinese-English, English-Chinese, Chinese-Russian, Russian-Chinese, Chinese-Japanese, Japanese-Chinese, Chinese-Korean, Korean-Chinese).

#### **5.4 Dialect Translation**

The device can recognize and translate specific Chinese dialects.

- In the language selection menu, choose the specific dialect (e.g., Cantonese, Sichuan dialect) as the source language.
- Proceed with voice translation as described in Section 5.1.

Note: Supported dialects include Cantonese, Sichuan dialect, Northeast dialect, and Henan dialect.

# 6. MAINTENANCE

## **6.1 Charging the Device**

- Use only the provided charging cable and a compatible 5V power adapter.
- · Avoid using damaged cables or chargers.
- Do not expose the device to extreme temperatures during charging.

#### 6.2 Cleaning

- Wipe the device with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- Do not use liquid cleaners, aerosols, or harsh chemicals.
- · Avoid getting moisture into openings.

### 6.3 Storage

- Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- If storing for an extended period, ensure the battery is partially charged (around 50%) to prolong battery life.

# 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not power on.	Low battery; device frozen.	Charge the device for at least 30 minutes. If still unresponsive, perform a hard reset (refer to specific device instructions for reset procedure, usually holding power button for 10+ seconds).

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Translation is inaccurate or slow.	Poor internet connection; unclear speech; incorrect language selection; using offline mode for unsupported languages.	Ensure a stable Wi-Fi or 4G connection. Speak clearly and directly into the microphone. Verify correct source and target languages. For offline translation, ensure language packs are installed and supported.
Photo translation not working or inaccurate.	Poor lighting; blurry image; text too small/complex; unsupported language.	Ensure adequate lighting and hold the device steady.  Make sure the text is clear and within the camera frame.  Verify the language is supported for photo translation.
Battery drains quickly.	High screen brightness; continuous Wi-Fi/4G usage; background apps.	Reduce screen brightness. Turn off Wi-Fi/4G when not needed. Close unnecessary applications.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi.	Incorrect password; out of range; network issue.	Double-check the Wi-Fi password. Move closer to the Wi-Fi router. Restart the device and the router.
