1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the installation, maintenance, and safe operation of your Buildalot Drive Belt, specifically designed for the Black & Decker KA85 power tool. 


Image: The Buildalot Drive Belt, a replacement part for the Black & Decker KA85 power tool.

4. INSTALLATION

The following steps provide general guidance for replacing a drive belt. Specific procedures may vary depending on your Black & Decker KA85 model. Always refer to your tool's original service manual for detailed instructions.

1. **Prepare the Tool:** Ensure the Black & Decker KA85 power tool is unplugged. Place it on a stable, clean work surface.
2. **Access the Belt Compartment:** Locate and remove the screws or clips securing the housing cover that encloses the drive belt. Carefully remove the cover.
3. **Remove Old Belt:** Gently pry off the old drive belt from the pulleys. Note its orientation and how it was routed.
4. **Clean Pulleys:** Clean any dust, debris, or old belt residue from the pulleys and surrounding areas.
5. **Install New Belt:** Carefully place the new Buildalot drive belt onto the smaller pulley first, then stretch it over the larger pulley. Ensure the belt is seated correctly in the grooves of both pulleys. Some users find it helpful to slightly warm the belt in warm water to increase flexibility for easier installation.
6. **Check Tension:** Once installed, the belt should be snug but not overly tight. It should have a small amount of play when pressed.
7. **Reassemble:** Replace the housing cover and secure it with the original screws or clips. Ensure all components are properly aligned and tightened.
8. **Test Functionality:** Plug in the power tool and briefly operate it at a low speed to ensure the belt runs smoothly without slipping or unusual noise.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance can extend the life of your drive belt and ensure consistent tool performance.

- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically inspect the drive belt for signs of wear, cracking, fraying, or stretching. Replace the belt if any damage is observed.
- **Keep Clean:** Keep the belt and pulley area free from dust, sawdust, and other debris, which can cause premature wear or slippage.
- **Avoid Overloading:** Do not overload the power tool, as excessive strain can cause the belt to slip or break.
- **Proper Storage:** When not in use, store the power tool in a clean, dry environment away from extreme temperatures.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues after installing the new drive belt, consider the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Belt slips during operation	Incorrect tension; oil/grease on belt/pulleys; worn pulleys	Adjust belt tension; clean belt and pulleys thoroughly; inspect pulleys for wear and replace if necessary.
Unusual noise (squealing, grinding)	Misaligned belt; worn bearings; debris in belt path	Check belt alignment; inspect bearings; clean belt path.
Belt breaks prematurely	Over-tightening; overloading tool; sharp edges on pulleys	Ensure correct tension; avoid overloading; inspect pulleys for burrs or sharp edges.
