

Greater Goods Silicone Ice Cube Trays with Lid Instruction Manual

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Greater Goods Silicone Ice Cube Trays with Lid are designed for convenient ice making and other freezing applications. Crafted from food-grade, BPA-free silicone, these trays facilitate easy ice release and are suitable for various uses, including cocktails, whiskey, and preparing baby food. Each pack includes two trays, with each tray producing fifteen medium-sized cubes. Grooved dividers ensure even cube formation and minimize spills. The included lids help prevent freezer odors from affecting the ice and allow for efficient stacking.



Go With the Flow

Grooved dividers distribute water more evenly so you get matching cubes for picture-perfect drinks.

2. SETUP AND FIRST USE

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the ice cube trays and lids from their packaging.
2. **Clean:** Before first use, wash both trays and lids thoroughly with warm, soapy water. Rinse completely and allow to air dry, or dry with a clean cloth. The trays are also dishwasher safe.
3. **Inspect:** Ensure there are no damages or defects to the silicone trays or plastic lids.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Filling the Trays:

Due to the flexible nature of silicone, it is recommended to place the tray on a flat, rigid surface (such as a cutting board or the included lid) before filling with liquid. This provides stability and prevents spillage during transfer. Fill each compartment with your desired liquid (water, juice, baby food puree, etc.). Avoid overfilling to prevent cubes from merging.

2. Applying the Lid:

Place the lid securely over the filled tray. The lid helps protect the contents from freezer odors and allows for stacking.

3. Freezing:

Carefully transfer the tray with the lid to your freezer. If stacking multiple trays, ensure the lids are properly seated to maintain stability.



No more twisting plastic or stuck cubes—press the silicone wells to easily pop out just the right amount of ice.

4. Removing Ice Cubes:

Once frozen, remove the lid. To release individual cubes, gently press on the bottom of each silicone compartment. The flexible silicone design allows for easy removal without twisting or excessive force.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** The silicone ice cube trays and lids are dishwasher safe. For hand washing, use warm water and mild dish soap. Ensure all residue is rinsed off.
- **Drying:** Allow components to air dry completely before storing to prevent water spots or mildew.
- **Storage:** Store the trays and lids in a clean, dry place. The stackable design allows for compact storage.
- **Odor Prevention:** While the lids help, silicone can absorb odors over time if left in the freezer for extended periods with strong-smelling foods. For best results, transfer frozen cubes to an airtight container for long-term storage.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem: Liquid spills when transferring the filled tray to the freezer.

Solution: Always place the flexible silicone tray on a flat, rigid surface (like the included lid or a baking sheet) before filling it with liquid. This provides stability and prevents bending during transfer.

Problem: Ice cubes are difficult to remove.

Solution: Ensure the cubes are fully frozen. Gently press on the bottom of each individual compartment to release the cube. Avoid twisting the entire tray forcefully, as this is not necessary with silicone.

Problem: Ice cubes have an odd taste or smell.

Solution: This can happen if ice absorbs odors from other foods in the freezer. Ensure the lid is properly placed on the tray. For long-term storage, transfer frozen cubes to an airtight container or freezer bag. Regularly clean the trays and your freezer.

Problem: Lids appear to have small holes.

Information: The lids are designed to fit over the trays and provide a barrier against most freezer odors and allow for stacking. While they offer significant protection, some designs may include small vents. For maximum odor protection, consider transferring cubes to an airtight container once frozen.
