1. IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons. Read all instructions carefully before operating the ZENY Air Fryer.

- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electric shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or the main unit in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- Ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, heat-resistant surface.
- Do not block any ventilation openings.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ZENY XXL 7.6QT Digital Air Fryer utilizes rapid hot air circulation technology to cook food with little to no oil, resulting in healthier meals. It features a digital touch screen for easy operation and pre-set cooking modes.

Components:

- **Main Unit:** Houses the heating element, fan, and control panel.
- **Digital Touch Screen:** For setting time, temperature, and selecting cooking modes.
- **Frying Basket:** The primary cooking container where food is placed.
- **Crisper Plate:** Inserted into the frying basket to allow air circulation around food and drain excess oil.
- **Handle:** For safely pulling out and inserting the frying basket.

3. SETUP AND FIRST USE

Unpacking:

1. Remove all packaging materials, stickers, and labels from the appliance.
2. Remove the frying basket and crisper plate from the main unit.

Cleaning Before First Use:

1. Wash the frying basket and crisper plate thoroughly with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive sponge. These parts are dishwasher safe.
2. Wipe the inside and outside of the main unit with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the main unit in water.
3. Ensure all parts are completely dry before use.

Placement:

- Place the air fryer on a stable, level, and heat-resistant surface.
- Ensure there is at least 4 inches (10 cm) of free space on the back and sides of the appliance, and 4 inches (10 cm) above it, to allow for proper air circulation.
- Do not place the appliance against a wall or other appliances.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The ZENY Air Fryer features a digital touch screen for intuitive control over cooking settings.

General Operation:

1. **Prepare Food:** Place your ingredients in the frying basket. Ensure the crisper plate is properly inserted at the bottom of the basket. Do not overfill the basket to allow for proper air circulation.
2. **Insert Basket:** Slide the frying basket back into the main unit until it clicks into place.
3. **Power On:** Plug the power cord into a grounded wall outlet. The digital screen will illuminate.
4. **Set Temperature and Time:** Use the touch controls on the digital screen to adjust the desired cooking temperature (up to 400°F) and time. The air fryer has a 1700W heating element for efficient cooking.

5. **Select Pre-set Mode (Optional):** The air fryer offers 7 pre-set cooking modes for common dishes. Select the appropriate mode for your food. This will automatically set optimal temperature and time, which can then be adjusted manually if needed.
6. **Start Cooking:** Press the start button to begin the cooking process. The air fryer will automatically preheat and then start cooking.
7. **Shake Basket (Optional):** For even cooking, some recipes may require shaking the basket halfway through the cooking time. Carefully pull out the basket using the handle, shake the contents, and then reinsert the basket. The air fryer will resume cooking automatically.
8. **Auto-Off Function:** The air fryer will automatically turn off once the set cooking time has elapsed. A timer will sound to indicate completion.
9. **Remove Food:** Carefully pull out the frying basket. Use heat-resistant tongs to remove the cooked food.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your ZENY Air Fryer.

Cleaning the Frying Basket and Crisper Plate:

- After each use, unplug the air fryer and allow it to cool completely.
- Remove the frying basket and crisper plate.
- Wash them in hot water with dish soap and a non-abrasive sponge. The non-stick coating makes cleaning easy.
- Alternatively, these parts are dishwasher safe for convenient cleaning.
- For stubborn food residue, soak the basket and plate in hot water with dish soap for about 10 minutes before cleaning.

Cleaning the Main Unit:

- Wipe the exterior of the air fryer with a damp cloth.
- Clean the interior of the appliance with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Never immerse the main unit in water or any other liquid.
- Ensure all parts are dry before storing or using again.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ZENY Air Fryer, consult the following table for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Air fryer does not turn on.	Appliance is not plugged in.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a grounded wall outlet.
Food is not cooked evenly.	Basket is overfilled; food not shaken.	Do not overfill the basket. Shake the basket halfway through cooking for even results.
White smoke comes from the appliance.	Grease residue from previous use; fatty ingredients.	Clean the basket and crisper plate thoroughly after each use. Remove excess fat from ingredients.
Food is not crispy.	Too much moisture; not enough oil (for certain foods).	Pat food dry before air frying. Lightly brush or spray with oil for extra crispiness.
