INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the GIANTZ Steel Base Garden Shed. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new garden shed. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

This garden shed is designed to provide ample storage space for gardening tools, equipment, and other outdoor items. Its robust construction ensures durability and protection against various weather conditions.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these safety instructions may result in serious injury or property damage.

- Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) during assembly, including gloves and eye protection. Metal edges can be sharp.
- Ensure the assembly area is clear of obstructions and well-lit.
- Do not attempt to assemble the shed alone. A minimum of two people is recommended for safe assembly.
- Secure the shed to a level, solid foundation to prevent tipping or collapse, especially in windy conditions.
- Keep children and pets away from the assembly area.
- Check all parts for damage before assembly. Do not use damaged parts.
- Do not climb on the shed roof.
- Ensure proper ventilation inside the shed, especially if storing items that may emit fumes.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Your GIANTZ Garden Shed package typically includes the following components. Please verify all parts are present before starting assembly.

- Galvanized Steel Panels (walls, roof)
- Steel Frame Components (beams, supports, base frame)

- Double Sliding Door Assembly
- Air Vents
- Fasteners (screws, nuts, bolts)
- Handles and Lock Mechanism
- Instruction Manual (this document)

Note: The shed comes in 3 packages. Ensure all packages are received before unpacking.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the GIANTZ Garden Shed requires patience and attention to detail. Follow the steps below carefully. It is highly recommended to have at least two people for assembly.

1. Site Preparation

Choose a level, solid site for your shed. A concrete slab or a well-compacted gravel base is ideal. The shed includes a steel base frame, but a stable foundation is crucial for long-term stability.

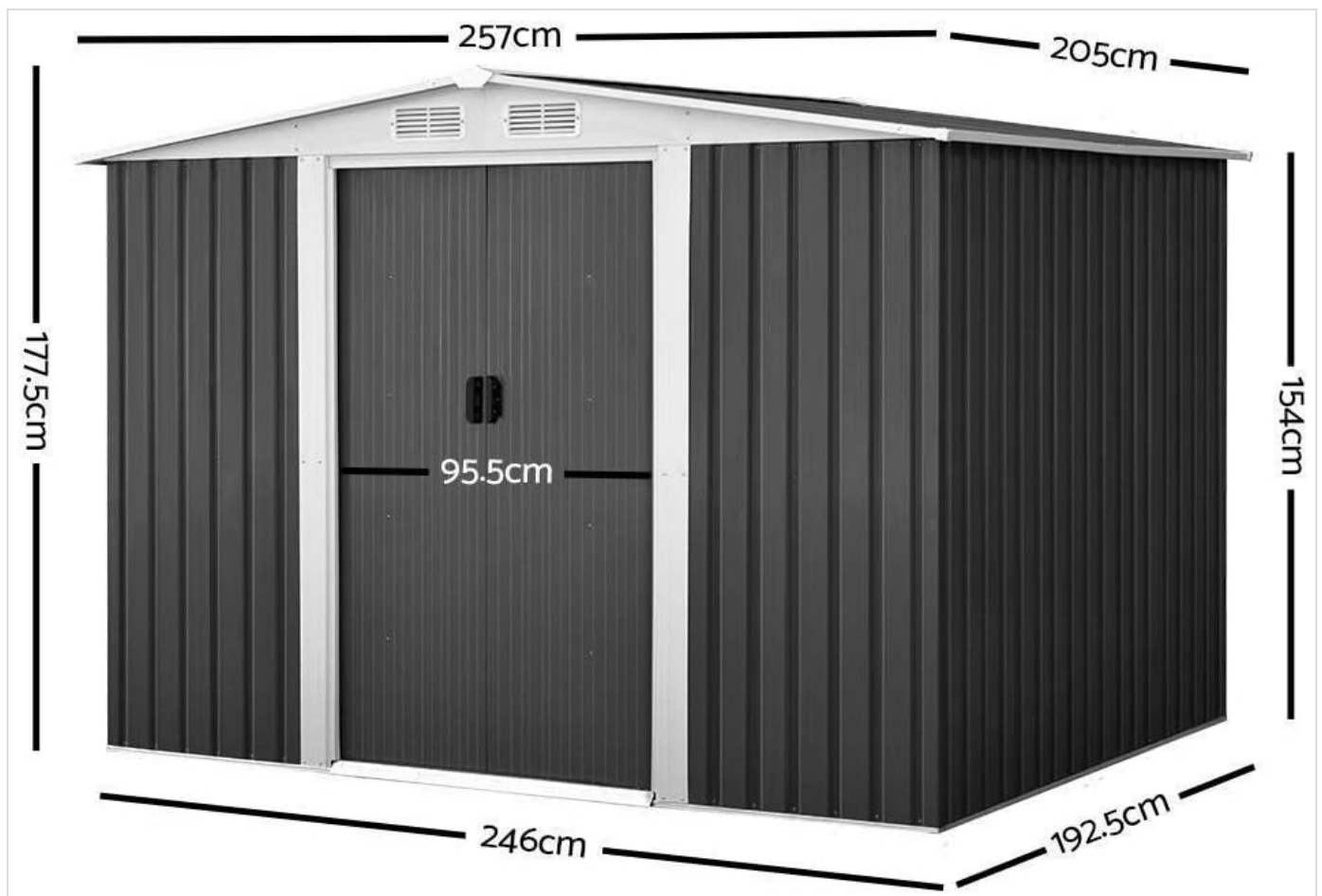


Figure 1: Shed Dimensions. Overall dimensions are approximately 257cm (length) x 205cm (width) x 177.5cm (height at peak). The double sliding door opening is 95.5cm wide and 154cm high.

2. Base Frame Assembly

Assemble the galvanized steel base frame according to the diagrams in the included assembly guide. Ensure all connections are secure and the frame is square before proceeding.

3. Wall Panel Installation

Attach the corrugated galvanized steel wall panels to the base frame and connect them to each other using the provided fasteners. Work systematically around the shed, ensuring panels are aligned correctly.

4. Roof Assembly

Install the roof support beams and then attach the roof panels. The sloped roof design facilitates water drainage. Ensure all roof panels overlap correctly and are securely fastened to prevent leaks.

5. Door and Vent Installation

Install the double sliding doors into their tracks. Attach the handles and the lock mechanism. Finally, install the four air vents, two on the front and two on the rear, ensuring they are securely in place for proper air circulation.

OPERATION

Your GIANTZ Garden Shed is designed for straightforward operation.

Opening and Closing Doors

The shed features double sliding doors. To open, simply slide one or both doors along their tracks. To close, slide them back until they meet in the center. Ensure the tracks are clear of debris for smooth operation.

Locking the Shed

A lock is included with the shed. Use the provided lock to secure the double sliding doors when not in use to protect your stored items.

Ventilation

The four air vents (two front, two rear) provide continuous air circulation to prevent stuffiness and condensation inside the shed. Do not block these vents.

MAINTENANCE

The GIANTZ Steel Base Garden Shed is designed to be largely maintenance-free due to its galvanized steel and polypropylene construction, which are corrosion-resistant and weatherproof. However, regular checks can extend its lifespan and ensure optimal performance.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically clean the exterior with mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that

could damage the finish.

- **Door Tracks:** Keep the sliding door tracks clear of dirt, leaves, and other debris to ensure smooth operation. Lubricate with a silicone spray if doors become stiff.
- **Fasteners:** Annually check all screws, nuts, and bolts for tightness. Re-tighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Foundation:** Ensure the shed's foundation remains stable and level. Address any settling or erosion promptly.
- **Vents:** Ensure air vents remain unobstructed for proper air circulation.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Doors are stiff or difficult to slide.	Debris in tracks; lack of lubrication; misaligned doors.	Clean tracks thoroughly. Apply silicone spray lubricant. Check door alignment and adjust if necessary.
Water leakage inside the shed.	Improperly sealed roof panels; damaged panels; inadequate foundation.	Inspect roof panel overlaps and seal any gaps with appropriate sealant. Check for damaged panels and replace if needed. Ensure shed is on a level foundation.
Shed feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose fasteners; uneven foundation; insufficient anchoring.	Tighten all screws and bolts. Ensure the foundation is level. Securely anchor the shed to the ground using appropriate anchors (not included).
Condensation inside the shed.	Blocked air vents; high humidity; lack of air circulation.	Ensure all four air vents are clear and unobstructed. Consider adding a dehumidifier if humidity is consistently high.
