1. Introduction

This manual provides instructions for the Satechi Aluminum Wired USB Keyboard with Numeric Keypad. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper operation and to understand its features.

The Satechi Aluminum Wired USB Keyboard is designed to enhance your typing experience with a full-size layout, numeric keypad, and responsive scissor switch keys. It features a reliable wired connection and shortcut keys optimized for Mac devices.

2. SETUP

2.1 Package Contents

- · Satechi Aluminum Wired USB Keyboard
- User Guide (this document)

2.2 System Requirements

- MacOS v10.4 or later
- Available USB-A port
- For 2016 and later MacBook models, a USB-C to USB-A adapter is required (not included).

2.3 Connecting the Keyboard

- 1. Locate an available USB-A port on your computer or compatible device.
- 2. Plug the USB-A cable from the Satechi keyboard into the USB-A port.
- 3. The keyboard is plug-and-play; no additional drivers or software installation is required.

3. OPERATION

3.1 Basic Typing

The keyboard functions as a standard QWERTY keyboard. Simply begin typing to input text into your device.

3.2 Function Keys (F1-F15)

The keyboard includes dedicated function keys optimized for Mac devices. These keys provide quick access to various system functions:

- **Fn Lock:** Toggles the primary function of the F-keys between standard F-key behavior and special Mac functions.
- F1: Decrease Brightness
- F2: Increase Brightness
- F3: Spotlight Search
- F4: Mission Control
- **F5**: App Switcher
- F7: Previous Track
- F8: Play/Pause
- F9: Next Track
- F10: Mute Volume
- F11: Volume Down
- F12: Volume Up
- Eject Key: Ejects optical media (if applicable to your system).
- Cut, Copy, Paste Keys: Dedicated keys for common editing functions.




Image: Overhead view of the Satechi keyboard highlighting the Mac OS function keys and their respective actions.

3.3 Numeric Keypad

The integrated numeric keypad allows for efficient data entry and calculations. It operates like a standard numeric keypad found on full-size keyboards.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning

- Disconnect the keyboard from your computer before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or solvents, as these can damage the keyboard's finish and keys.
- For dust and debris between keys, use compressed air.

4.2 Storage

Store the keyboard in a dry environment, away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight, when not in use for extended periods.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 Keyboard Not Responding

• Ensure the USB cable is securely plugged into both the keyboard and the computer's USB-A port.

- Try plugging the keyboard into a different USB-A port on your computer.
- If using a USB hub or adapter, try connecting the keyboard directly to the computer if possible, or try a different hub/adapter.
- · Restart your computer.

5.2 Specific Keys Not Working

- Check for any physical obstructions or debris under the affected keys. Gently clean the area with compressed air.
- Ensure the Fn Lock is not inadvertently activated if you are expecting standard F-key behavior.
- Test the keyboard on another computer to determine if the issue is with the keyboard or the computer's software/settings.

5.3 Function Keys Not Working Correctly

- Verify that your operating system is MacOS v10.4 or later.
- Check your system preferences for keyboard settings that might alter function key behavior.




