SETUP



- **Zipper Care:** Keep zippers clean and free of debris. Periodically apply a silicone-based lubricant to ensure smooth operation.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions:

• Blind Not Staying Securely Attached:

Solution: Ensure all bungee cords are properly attached and tightened. Check for any damaged cords or attachment points. If the blind frequently detaches, consider reinforcing attachment points or using additional securing methods.

• Zipper Malfunction (Sticking or Breaking):

Solution: Keep the zipper path clear of fabric and debris. Apply a zipper lubricant (e.g., silicone spray or wax) to the teeth. If the zipper is broken, it may require professional repair or replacement.

• Fabric Tearing or Fading:

Solution: While the fabric is durable, extreme weather or prolonged exposure to harsh elements can cause wear. Avoid sharp objects. For fading, this is often a natural process over time with sun exposure; proper storage when not in use can mitigate this. Small tears can often be repaired with fabric repair kits designed for outdoor gear.

Missing Components (e.g., Snaps, Cords):

Solution: Carefully inspect the packaging upon receipt. If components are missing, contact Muddy customer support immediately for assistance.

· Poor Fit on Stand:

Solution: Verify that the blind kit is the correct size for your specific stand model. Ensure it is installed evenly and all attachment points are utilized. Adjust tension on bungee cords to achieve a better fit.
