INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Tefal OptiGrill+ XL GC722. This electric grill is designed to provide perfectly cooked results for various food types, from rare to well-done, thanks to its automatic cooking programs and thickness measurement. Please read this manual carefully before first use to ensure safe and optimal operation of your appliance.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- Read all instructions before use.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner. Return appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair, or adjustment.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- This appliance is for household use only.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Tefal OptiGrill+ XL GC722 is an advanced electric grill designed for precision cooking. It features a large grilling surface, automatic cooking programs, and a patented automatic thickness sensor.

Main Components

- Grill body with integrated control panel
- Removable non-stick grill plates
- Large capacity drip tray
- Power cord

SETUP

Before using your OptiGrill+ XL for the first time, follow these steps:

1. **Unpack:** Remove all packaging materials, stickers, and accessories from the appliance.
2. **Clean Plates:** Wipe the grill plates and drip tray with a sponge and hot water, then dry thoroughly. The plates and drip tray are dishwasher safe.
3. **Position:** Place the drip tray in front of the grill. Ensure the grill is placed on a stable, heat-resistant surface.
4. **Insert Plates:** Ensure the grill plates are correctly installed and locked into place.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The OptiGrill+ XL features automatic cooking programs and a manual mode for versatile grilling.

Automatic Cooking Programs

The grill has 9 automatic programs for different food types:

- Red Meat
- Burger
- Poultry
- Sausage
- Fish
- Seafood

- Bacon
- Pork
- Sandwich/Panini

Cooking Process:

1. **Plug In:** Plug the appliance into a wall outlet. The power button will flash.
2. **Power On:** Press the power button. The preheating indicator will flash.
3. **Select Program:** Press the 'M' button to cycle through the cooking programs. Once selected, press 'OK'.
4. **Preheating:** The grill will begin preheating. The indicator light will be purple and beep when preheating is complete.
5. **Place Food:** Open the grill and place your food on the cooking plates. Close the lid.

6. **Automatic Cooking:** The grill will automatically detect the thickness of the food and adapt the cooking cycle. The indicator light will change color to show the cooking progress (yellow for rare, orange for medium, red for well-done).
7. **Remove Food:** When the desired doneness is reached, remove the food. You can leave other pieces to cook longer if needed.

Manual Mode

For custom cooking or foods not covered by automatic programs, use manual mode:

- After pressing the power button, select the manual mode icon (usually represented by a thermometer or chef's hat icon).
- Adjust the temperature using the temperature control button if available.
- Preheat the grill. Once preheated, place your food.
- Monitor cooking manually and remove food when done.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning ensures the longevity and performance of your OptiGrill+ XL.

1. **Unplug and Cool:** Always unplug the grill and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. **Remove Drip Tray:** Empty and clean the drip tray after each use. It is dishwasher safe.
3. **Remove Grill Plates:** Press the release buttons to detach the grill plates.

4. **Clean Plates:** Wash the grill plates with warm, soapy water or place them in the dishwasher. Do not use abrasive cleaning pads or harsh detergents.
5. **Clean Body:** Wipe the grill body with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the grill body in water or any other liquid.
6. **Storage:** Once clean and dry, store the grill in a dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your OptiGrill+ XL, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Grill does not turn on.	Not plugged in or power outlet issue.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check the circuit breaker.
Preheating takes too long.	Grill plates are not properly installed or cold.	Ensure plates are correctly locked in place. Allow sufficient time for preheating, especially if the grill is very cold.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Food is not cooked evenly.	Food thickness variation or improper placement.	Ensure food pieces are of similar thickness. Distribute food evenly on the plates.
Smoke coming from the grill.	Excess fat buildup or food residue.	Clean the grill plates and drip tray thoroughly after each use. Ensure no food residue is left on heating elements.
Indicator light not changing color.	Sensor malfunction or incorrect program selection.	Ensure the lid is fully closed during cooking. Try unplugging and replugging the unit. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
