3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. **Power Off:** Always unplug the aquarium filter unit from the power outlet before performing any maintenance.
2. **Remove Old Cartridge:** Carefully open the filter housing and remove the used filter cartridge. Dispose of the old cartridge responsibly.
3. **Rinse New Cartridge:** Gently rinse the new DaToo DTF-01 Replacement Aquarium Filter Cartridge under cool tap water for a few seconds. This helps remove any loose carbon dust.
4. **Insert New Cartridge:** Place the rinsed new cartridge into the designated slot within the filter housing. Ensure it is seated correctly to allow proper water flow.
5. **Close Housing:** Securely close the filter housing.
6. **Power On:** Plug the aquarium filter unit back into the power outlet.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure continuous optimal filtration and water quality, regular maintenance of your filter cartridges is essential.

- **Replacement Frequency:** It is recommended to change the filter cartridge every 4 to 6 weeks. This frequency may vary depending on the fish load and tank conditions.
- **Visual Inspection:** Periodically check the filter cartridge for signs of heavy clogging or degradation. If the water flow is significantly reduced or the cartridge appears heavily soiled before the recommended replacement period, replace it sooner.
- **Never Rinse with Hot Water:** When rinsing a new cartridge, use cool tap water. Avoid hot water as it can damage the filter media.
- **Avoid Cleaning with Soaps/Detergents:** Never use soaps or detergents to clean the filter cartridges or any part of your aquarium filter, as these can be toxic to fish.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Reduced Water Flow	Clogged filter cartridge.	Replace the filter cartridge.
Cloudy Water	Filter cartridge is saturated or ineffective.	Replace the filter cartridge. Ensure proper tank maintenance (water changes, appropriate feeding).
Unpleasant Odor	Activated carbon in the cartridge is exhausted.	Replace the filter cartridge.
Filter Not Operating	Power issue, filter unit malfunction.	Check power connection. Refer to the DaToo Aquarium Filter DTF-01 unit manual for troubleshooting the main filter unit.
