Beliani Savona 300 cm Garden Parasol Instruction Manual

Model: 90304

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Beliani Savona 300 cm Garden Parasol. Please read all instructions carefully before use and retain this manual for future reference.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- **Base Weight:** Ensure the parasol base is adequately weighted. A minimum weight of 50 kg is recommended for stability.
- **Wind Conditions:** This parasol is designed for wind forces up to 25 km/h. In strong winds or adverse weather conditions, close and secure the parasol to prevent damage or injury.
- **Crank Mechanism:** When opening or closing the parasol, stop turning the crank once the canopy is fully open or closed. Continuing to turn the crank in the same direction can damage the mechanism.
- **Storage:** If the parasol cannot be stored indoors when not in use, cover it with a protective cover to prolong its lifespan.
- **Assembly:** Partial assembly is required. Follow the assembly steps carefully.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Beliani Savona parasol requires partial assembly. Please allow 5-15 minutes for this process. Ensure all components are present before beginning.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, flat surface. Verify that all parts are accounted for.
2. **Assemble the Base:** Connect the cross-shaped base components. Ensure they are securely fastened.
3. **Attach the Main Pole:** Insert the main pole into the assembled base. Secure it using the provided fasteners.

4. **Attach the Canopy Arm:** Connect the parasol canopy arm to the main pole. This typically involves sliding it into a bracket and securing it with a pin or bolt.
5. **Secure the Canopy:** Ensure the canopy is properly attached to the arm and ribs.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Beliani Savona parasol features an easy-to-use crank mechanism for opening and closing, along with

360-degree rotation and a tilting function for optimal shade positioning.

1. **Opening the Parasol:** Locate the crank handle on the main pole. Turn the crank clockwise to extend the canopy. Continue until the canopy is fully open and taut. Do not overtighten.
2. **Closing the Parasol:** Turn the crank handle counter-clockwise to retract the canopy. Continue until the canopy is fully closed and secured. Do not force the mechanism.
3. **360-Degree Rotation:** To rotate the parasol, loosen the locking mechanism near the base of the main pole (if present). Carefully rotate the entire parasol to the desired position, then re-tighten the locking mechanism.
4. **Tilting the Canopy:** The parasol features a tilting shade. Use the designated lever or button on the canopy arm to adjust the angle of the canopy for optimal sun protection.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning the Canopy:** Clean the fabric canopy regularly with a mild soap solution and water. Use a soft brush or cloth. Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry completely before closing or storing.
- **Frame Care:** Wipe the aluminum frame with a damp cloth to remove dirt and dust. Avoid abrasive cleaners.

- **Storage:** For prolonged periods of non-use, especially during winter or harsh weather, it is recommended to store the parasol indoors. If indoor storage is not possible, use a weather-resistant protective cover.
- **Water Resistance:** The canopy offers light water resistance, allowing for use during light rain and humid conditions. However, prolonged exposure to heavy rain or moisture can cause damage.

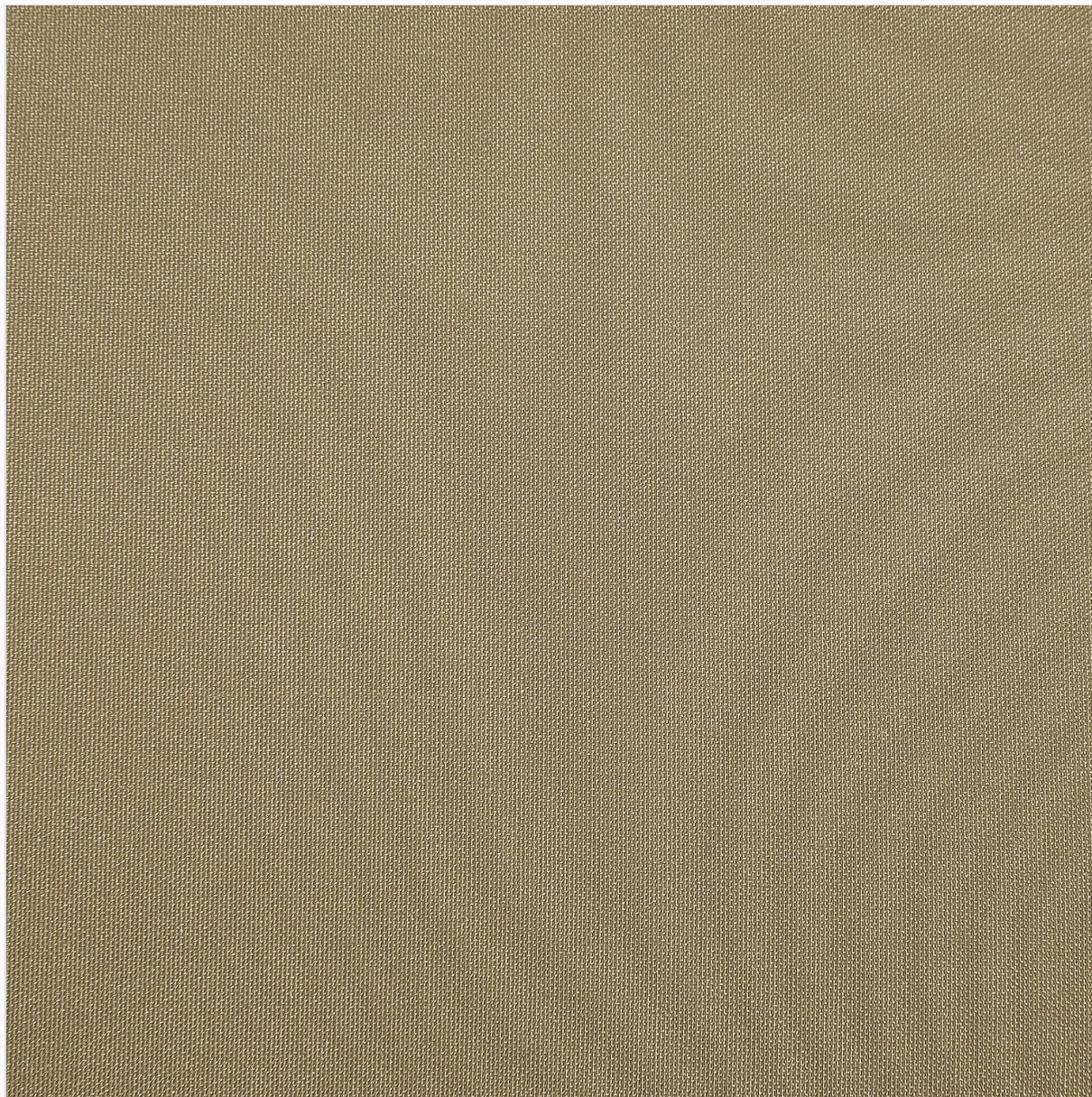


Image: A close-up view of the beige fabric used for the parasol canopy, showing its texture and weave.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Parasol Instability:** Ensure the base is weighted with at least 50 kg. Check that all connections between the pole and base are secure. Avoid use in winds exceeding 25 km/h.
- **Crank Mechanism Jammed:** Do not force the crank. Check for any obstructions in the canopy or mechanism. Ensure you are not overtightening when opening or closing.
- **Canopy Not Opening/Closing Smoothly:** Inspect the ribs and fabric for any damage or entanglement. Ensure the mechanism is clean and free of debris.

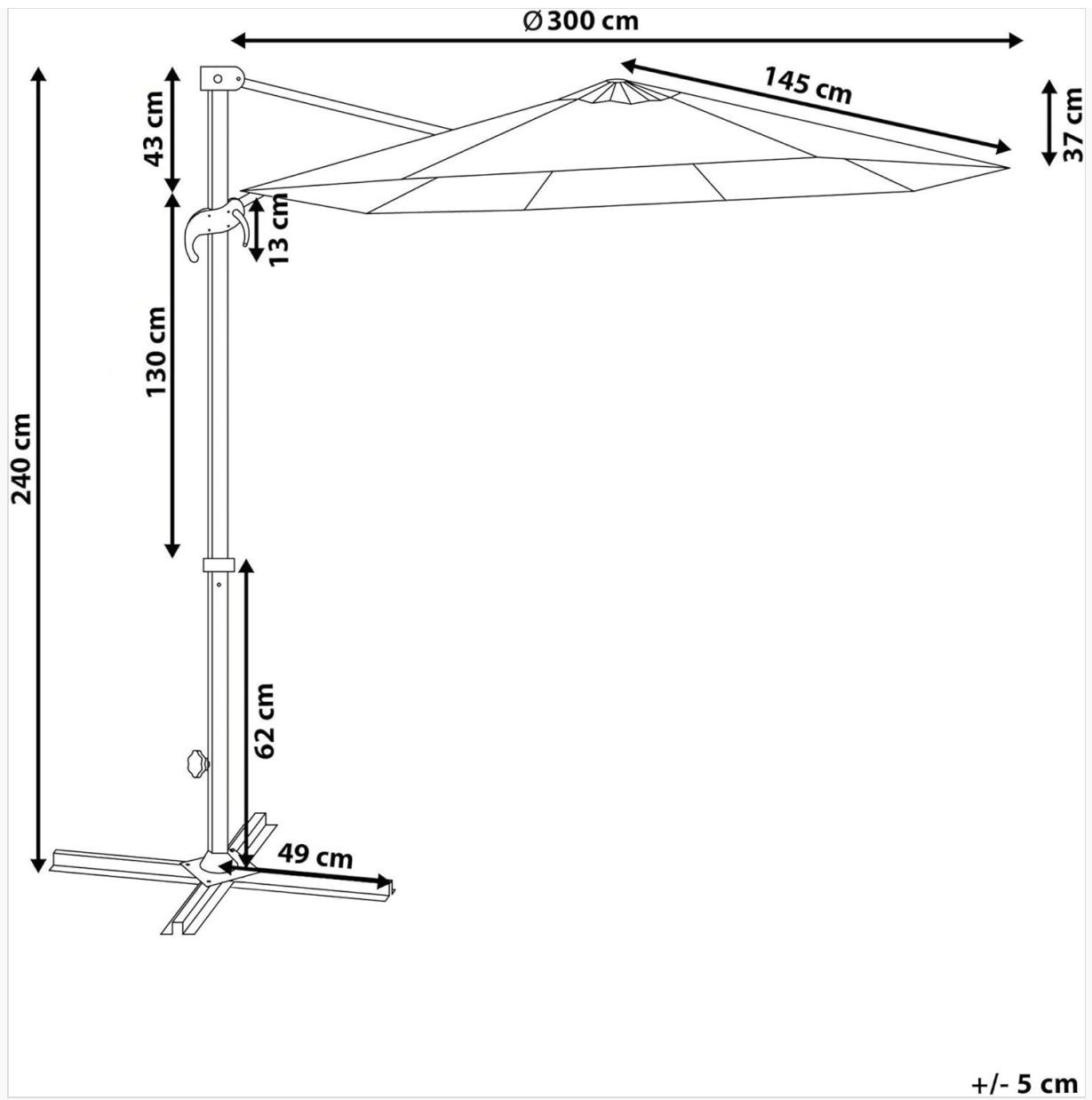


Image: Technical diagram illustrating the dimensions of the parasol, including height, width, and canopy diameter.
