## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides instructions for the proper use and care of your SportDOG Basic Training DVD. ## SETUP

---




Image: The SportDOG Basic Training DVD cover. This image illustrates the product packaging and design.

- **Storage:** Store the DVD in its original case when not in use. Keep it away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- **Avoid Scratches:** Do not place the DVD on rough surfaces or allow it to come into contact with sharp objects.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues while playing the DVD, consider the following solutions:

Problem	Solution
DVD does not play or load.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ensure the DVD is inserted correctly.</li><li>• Clean the DVD surface with a soft cloth.</li><li>• Try playing another DVD to confirm your player is working.</li><li>• Restart your DVD player or computer.</li></ul>
Video or audio skips/freezes.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Clean the DVD surface for smudges or dust.</li><li>• Check the DVD for deep scratches. Minor scratches may sometimes be repaired with a DVD repair kit.</li><li>• Ensure your DVD player's lens is clean (refer to your player's manual).</li></ul>
No sound.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Check your TV/receiver volume and mute settings.</li><li>• Ensure audio cables are securely connected.</li><li>• Verify the correct audio output is selected on your DVD player/TV.</li></ul>
