1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions and warnings before using the Bright Starts Giggling Safari Walker. Keep these instructions for future reference.

- **Age and Weight Limits:** Suitable for children aged 6 months and up who can sit up unassisted. Maximum weight capacity is 12 kilograms (26.5 lbs).
- **Supervision:** Always keep your child in view while they are in the walker. Never leave a child unattended.
- **Hazard Prevention:** Ensure the child cannot reach stairs, steps, or uneven surfaces. Keep the child away from hot liquids, electrical cords, stoves, heaters, and other potential hazards.
- **Stability:** The walker features a sturdy frame and rubber feet designed to provide stability and act as 'brakes' on uneven surfaces. Regularly inspect these components for wear.
- **Assembly:** Ensure all parts are correctly assembled and securely fastened before each use.

3. ASSEMBLY

4. SETUP

4.1 Adjusting Height Positions

The walker offers three adjustable height positions to ensure your child's feet can comfortably touch the floor. To adjust the height:

1. Locate the height adjustment mechanism on the underside of the walker.
2. Press the release buttons or levers (refer to your manual for exact location).
3. Raise or lower the seat to the desired position. Ensure both sides click securely into place.
4. Verify that the child's feet are flat on the floor or slightly on the balls of their feet, not tip-toeing or with knees bent excessively.

4.2 Folding for Storage

For easy storage or transport, the walker can be folded flat:

1. Ensure the child is removed from the walker.
2. Locate the folding mechanism (usually a latch or button on the frame).

3. Follow the instructions in your manual to release the lock and fold the frame inward until it lies flat.

4.3 Battery Installation (for Toy Bar)

The interactive toy bar requires batteries for lights and sounds. (Battery type and quantity are typically specified on the toy bar itself or in the manual).

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the toy bar.
2. Using a screwdriver, open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert the required batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Replace the cover and secure it with the screw.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Placing Your Child in the Walker

Carefully place your child into the walker's seat, ensuring their legs are positioned correctly through the leg openings and they are comfortably seated with their back against the high seat back.

5.2 Interacting with the Toy Bar

The toy bar features a steering wheel that activates lights and sounds. There is also a volume control switch, allowing you to adjust the sound level or turn it off completely.

The two link loops on the walker provide additional attachment points for your child's favorite toys or teethers, enhancing their play experience.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and hygiene of your Bright Starts Giggling Safari Walker.

- **Seat Pad:** The fabric seat pad is machine washable. Remove it from the walker frame and wash according to the care label instructions (typically cold water, gentle cycle). Air dry or tumble dry on low.
- **Frame and Toys:** The plastic frame and attached toys can be wiped clean with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not immerse the toy bar in water due to electronic components.
- **Wheels:** Periodically check the wheels for any accumulated dirt, hair, or debris that may hinder smooth movement. Clean as necessary.

- **Storage:** When not in use, store the walker in a clean, dry place, preferably folded flat to save space.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Bright Starts Giggling Safari Walker, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **Walker not moving smoothly:** Check the wheels for any obstructions (e.g., carpet fibers, hair) and remove them. Ensure the walker is on a suitable flat surface.
- **Toy bar not producing sounds/lights:** Verify that the batteries are correctly installed and not depleted. Replace batteries if necessary. Check the volume switch to ensure it is not set to the 'off' position.
- **Difficulty adjusting height or folding:** Ensure all locking mechanisms are fully disengaged before attempting to adjust or fold. Do not force components. Refer to the assembly section of your manual for specific instructions.
