SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps carefully to ensure a secure and stable setup of your Thule Residence G3.

- 1. Prepare the Awning:** Fully extend your Thule Omnistor 5102 awning. Ensure the awning is clean and free of debris.
- 2. Attach Side Panels:** Identify the left and right side panels. Slide the keder strip of each side panel into the corresponding channel on the awning cassette. Secure the panels to the vertical support legs of the awning using the integrated straps or zippers.
- 3. Install Front Panel:** Unroll the front panel. Slide its keder strip into the front channel of the awning lead rail. Connect the front panel to the side panels using the zippers provided. Ensure all zippers are fully closed for a tight seal.
- 4. Insert Roof Poles (if applicable):** If your model includes roof poles, insert them into the designated pockets on the inside of the roof fabric and extend them to create tension.
- 5. Secure to Ground:** Use the provided pegs and guy ropes to firmly secure the base of the enclosure to the ground. Ensure the enclosure is taut to prevent flapping in windy conditions.
- 6. Adjust Tension:** Check all connections and adjust tension straps as needed to ensure the enclosure is stable and wrinkle-free.

OPERATING THE ENCLOSURE

The Thule Residence G3 is designed for ease of use once set up.

- Opening/Closing Windows:** The large clear windows can be rolled up and secured with toggles for ventilation or left down for protection and privacy.

- **Ventilation:** Utilize the integrated mesh panels on the side walls for airflow while keeping insects out. These can typically be zipped open or closed.
- **Entry/Exit:** The front panel often features a zippered door for convenient entry and exit.
- **Disassembly:** To disassemble, reverse the setup steps. Ensure all components are clean and dry before packing away to prevent mold and mildew.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will prolong the life of your Thule Residence G3.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the fabric with mild soap and lukewarm water. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry completely before storage.
- **Zippers:** Keep zippers clean and lubricated with a silicone-based spray to ensure smooth operation.
- **Storage:** Store the enclosure in a dry, cool place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure it is completely dry to prevent mold and mildew.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all components for wear and tear, especially seams, zippers, and attachment points. Repair any damage promptly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

- **Difficulty Zipping Panels:** Ensure panels are aligned correctly and the fabric is not caught in the zipper. Lubricate zippers if they are stiff.
- **Water Leaks:** Check all seams for proper sealing. Ensure the awning is pitched correctly to allow water runoff. Apply seam sealer if necessary.
- **Enclosure Not Taut:** Re-adjust tension straps and ensure all ground pegs are securely anchored. Check that roof poles (if used) are fully extended and locked.
- **Wind Noise/Flapping:** Ensure all panels are securely zipped and tensioned. Add additional guy ropes if in very windy conditions.





