1. Introduction

The GE Profile Opal Cleaning Kit is specifically designed for the routine maintenance of your GE Profile Opal Nugget Ice Maker. Regular cleaning is crucial for optimal performance, ensuring your ice tastes fresh, and extending the lifespan of your appliance. This kit provides a highly effective, nearly odorless cleaning solution to remove internal and external mineral and calcium build-up.

2. PRODUCT CONTENTS

Your GE Profile Opal Cleaning Kit includes the following items:

- One (1) 5 oz bottle of Opal Cleaning Solution (Highly Concentrated)
- One (1) Cleaning Cloth

3. KEY BENEFITS

Using the Opal Cleaning Kit regularly provides several advantages for your ice maker:

- Extends the Life of Your Ice Maker: Regular maintenance helps prevent wear and tear caused by mineral build-up.
- Helps Keep Ice Tasting Fresh: Removes internal scale and ensures the purity of your ice.
- Removes Mineral & Calcium Build-Up: The concentrated formula effectively dissolves hard water deposits.

4. SETUP FOR CLEANING

- 1. **Position Near a Sink:** For ease of draining, position your ice maker close to a sink.
- 2. **Remove Water Filter (if applicable):** If your Opal ice maker has a water filter, remove it before starting the cleaning process. Some models may have a filter that can remain installed during cleaning; refer to your ice maker's specific manual.
- 3. **Remove Side Tank (if applicable):** If your ice maker has a side tank accessory, remove it. The side tank will not be used during the main cleaning cycle.
- 4. **Drain Water from Machine:** Locate the two drain tubes at the back of the ice maker. Open both tubes to allow all water to drain from the machine. Ensure the reservoir is completely empty.
- 5. **Cap Drain Tubes:** Once drained, securely cap both drain tubes. Note that one tube is typically labeled for the side tank.

5. CLEANING PROCEDURE

Follow these steps to clean your GE Profile Opal Nugget Ice Maker:

- 1. Fill Reservoir: Fill the ice maker's internal reservoir with fresh water up to the maximum fill line.
- 2. **Add Cleaning Solution:** Pour 2.5 ounces of the Opal Cleaning Solution into the reservoir. The kit contains two 2.5-ounce portions, allowing for two cleaning cycles.
- 3. **Initiate Clean Cycle:** Ensure the ice maker is plugged in and powered on. Press and hold the 'Clean' button for 3 seconds until the 'Cleaning' indicator light illuminates. The machine will run a cleaning cycle for approximately 3 minutes, circulating the solution.
- 4. **Soak and Descale:** After the 3-minute cycle, the machine will stop. Place the provided cleaning cloth (or a paper towel) into the chute where the water flows down. Ensure it soaks up the cleaning solution and remains in place. Allow the solution to soak for 18 hours to effectively descale the internal components, including the sensors and chute. This extended soak is crucial for dissolving stubborn mineral deposits.
- 5. Wipe Down Components: While the solution is soaking, use the cleaning cloth saturated with the solution to wipe down the inside of the ice bucket and any accessible areas that accumulate hard water deposits. Always wear gloves when handling the cleaning solution.
- 6. **Drain Solution:** After the 18-hour soak, open both drain tubes at the back of the machine to completely drain the cleaning solution. Remove the cleaning cloth/paper towel.
- 7. **Rinse Cycles (3 Times):** Fill the reservoir with fresh water (no solution). Initiate a 3-minute clean cycle by holding the 'Clean' button for 3 seconds. After the cycle, drain the water from both tubes. Repeat this fresh water rinse and drain process two more times (total of 3 rinses) to ensure all chemical residue is removed.
- 8. **Final Rinse (Optional for Side Tank):** If you have a side tank with hard water deposits, you can fill it with 4 ounces of the cleaning solution and water, let it soak, and then scrub it with a brush. Rinse thoroughly.



- Use regularly for best performance.
- The icemaker will indicate when it is time to clean the unit.
- Use more frequently if you have hard water. We recommend using the cleaning kit based on your water conditions.

6. MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

It is recommended to use the GE Profile Opal Cleaning Kit every 6 months. However, if you have hard water conditions, you may need to clean your ice maker more frequently to prevent excessive mineral build-up and maintain optimal performance.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING & FAQs

- Why should I clean my nugget ice maker?
 Regular cleaning keeps it functioning efficiently. Be sure to sanitize and descale it to prevent mineral build-up and ensure fresh-tasting ice.
- How can I ensure my ice maker runs smoothly?
 In addition to sanitizing and descaling, maintain a 4-inch clearance on all sides, use distilled water, and ensure side tank tubes lie flat.

- Is it normal for my ice maker to make noise?
 Yes, occasional noise is normal. Verify there's water in the reservoir and that air vents are unobstructed. If noise continues, contact the Opal concierge team.
- Ice maker display ring is solid yellow: This indicates it is time to clean the unit. Follow the cleaning procedure outlined in this manual.
