# **Mksutary Walkie Talkies for Kids - Instruction Manual**

Model: XF-638

#### INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing Mksutary Walkie Talkies. This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your new 2-way radios. Designed for children aged 3-12, these walkie talkies offer reliable communication for various activities, fostering interaction and adventure.



#### **SAFETY INFORMATION**

- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Remove batteries if the device will not be used for an extended period.
- · Keep away from water and moisture unless explicitly stated as waterproof. This model is rated as waterproof.
- Supervise children during use to ensure proper handling and safety.
- Avoid exposing the device to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight for prolonged periods.

#### PACKAGE CONTENTS

The Mksutary Walkie Talkies package includes the following items:

- 8 x Walkie Talkies (Model XF-638)
- 1 x 1-to-4 Power Charger (for charging rechargeable batteries, batteries not included)
- User Manual (this document)

### **S**ETUP

#### 1. Battery Installation

Each walkie talkie requires 3 AA alkaline batteries or AAA rechargeable batteries (not included). Ensure correct polarity when inserting batteries.

- 1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the walkie talkie.
- 2. Slide the battery cover downwards to open.
- 3. Insert 3 AA batteries, matching the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals as indicated inside the compartment.
- 4. Close the battery cover by sliding it upwards until it clicks into place.

**Note:** The included charger is for rechargeable batteries only. Attempting to charge non-rechargeable batteries can cause damage or fire. The charging ports are located under the rubber flap next to the antenna.

# 2. Product Components

Component	Function	
Antenna	Transmits and receives radio signals.	
LCD Display	Shows channel number, battery level, and other indicators.	
PTT (Push-to-Talk) Button	Press and hold to transmit your voice.	
Power On/Off Button	Turns the device on or off.	
Menu Button	Accesses settings and options.	
Up/Down Buttons	Navigates through menu options and changes channels.	
Speaker	Outputs received audio.	
Microphone	Captures your voice for transmission.	
Recharge Port	Connects to the charger for rechargeable batteries.	

Component	Function
Earphone Port	For connecting an earphone (not included).
Belt Clip	Attaches the walkie talkie to clothing or a belt.

### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### 1. Power On/Off

Press and hold the **ON** button (located on the front, below the LCD) for approximately 3 seconds to turn the walkie talkie on or off. A beep sound will confirm the action.

#### 2. Channel Selection

Your walkie talkies have 22 available channels. To communicate, all walkie talkies must be set to the same channel.

- 1. Press the **MENU** button once. The channel number on the LCD display will start flashing.
- 2. Use the **UP** (▲) or **DOWN** (▼) buttons to select your desired channel (1-22).
- 3. Press the PTT button (on the side of the walkie talkie) to confirm and save the selected channel.

#### 3. Transmitting and Receiving

• To **Transmit**: Press and hold the **PTT** button. Speak clearly into the microphone (located below the speaker). Release the PTT button when you finish speaking.

• To **Receive**: Ensure the PTT button is not pressed. The walkie talkie will automatically receive transmissions from other units on the same channel.

### 4. VOX (Voice Operated Exchange) Function

The VOX function allows for hands-free communication. When activated, the walkie talkie will automatically transmit when it detects your voice, without needing to press the PTT button.

- 1. To activate VOX: Simultaneously press both the **ON** button and the **PTT** button.
- 2. The VOX sensitivity can be adjusted (3 levels) via the menu. Refer to the full manual for detailed menu navigation.

#### MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the exterior of the walkie talkie. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the walkie talkies in a cool, dry place when not in use. Remove batteries if storing for extended periods to prevent leakage.
- Battery Care: If using rechargeable batteries, ensure they are fully charged before long periods of non-use.

# **T**ROUBLESHOOTING

Problem Possible Cause
------------------------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Batteries are dead or incorrectly installed.	Replace batteries or ensure correct polarity. If using rechargeable, ensure they are charged.
Cannot communicate with other units	Units are on different channels. Out of range.	Ensure all units are on the same channel. Move closer to the other unit.
Poor sound quality / Static	Weak signal, interference, low battery.	Move to an open area. Check battery level. Avoid obstacles like buildings or dense foliage.
VOX not working	VOX not activated or sensitivity too low.	Activate VOX (ON + PTT). Adjust VOX sensitivity in the menu.
