INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your QNIGLO LD666 Wireless Intercom System. This system is designed to facilitate clear and private communication across various rooms or departments within homes or offices, offering a long-range solution with multiple channels and digital codes.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The QNIGLO LD666 Wireless Intercom System features a compact design with an integrated speaker, microphone, and a numeric keypad for channel selection. It includes dedicated buttons for VOX (Voice Activated), Group, Monitor, Call, and Talk functions, along with volume controls. The unit is powered via a DC 5V input and includes an antenna for wireless communication.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Power Connection:** Connect the provided power adapter to the DC 5V port on the back of each intercom unit. Plug the adapter into a standard electrical outlet.
2. **Antenna:** Ensure the antenna is securely attached and positioned upright for optimal signal reception.
3. **Digital Code Setting:** Locate the A/B/C switch on the back of the unit. Set all intercom units to the same digital code (A, B, or C) to enable communication between them. Units with different digital codes cannot communicate.
4. **Channel Setting:** Press and hold any numeric key (1-9, 0) for 3 seconds to set the desired communication channel. After setting, the intercom will automatically revert to its original channel. To lock a channel, long press the channel number for up to 3 seconds until you hear a "beep" voice. All units intended to communicate must be set to the same channel and digital code.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Basic Communication (Talk):** To speak, press and hold the large "TALK" button. Release the button to listen. Ensure the receiving unit is on the same channel and digital code.
- 2. VOX Mode (Voice Activated):** Press the "VOX" button to activate voice-activated transmission. In this mode, you do not need to press the "TALK" button to speak; the unit will transmit automatically when it detects your voice. The receiving unit will still need to press the "TALK" button to respond, or also be in VOX mode.
- 3. Call Mode:** To call a specific unit, press the "CALL" button. This sends an alert tone to the receiving unit on the same channel and digital code. This function is useful for urgent contact.
- 4. Group Mode:** To communicate with all connected intercom units simultaneously, press and hold the "GROUP" button. This is ideal for broadcasting messages to multiple locations, even if units are on different channels but

within the same digital code.

5. **Monitor Function:** To monitor a room (e.g., a baby's room or an elderly person's room), place an intercom unit in that room and press the "MONITOR" button on that unit. This unit will then stay in transmit mode, allowing you to listen in from another intercom unit.
6. **Volume Adjustment:** Use the "VOL-" and "VOL+" buttons to adjust the speaker volume to a comfortable level.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your QNIGLO LD666 Wireless Intercom System, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the unit. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials, as these can damage the surface or internal components.
- **Power Supply:** Always use the original power adapter provided with the system. Ensure the power port is free from dust and debris.

- **Environment:** Avoid exposing the units to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, high humidity, or dusty environments. While the unit is water-resistant, it is not waterproof; avoid direct contact with water.
- **Storage:** If storing the units for an extended period, disconnect them from power and store them in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your intercom system, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No communication between units	Units are on different channels or digital codes.	Ensure all communicating units are set to the same digital code (A, B, or C) and the same channel number. Refer to "Setup Instructions".
Poor sound quality or static	Interference from other devices; units are too far apart or obstructed.	Try changing to a different channel or digital code. Ensure units are within the specified range (up to 5280 feet in open areas). Reduce obstructions between units.
Unit not powering on	Power adapter not connected or faulty; power outlet issue.	Check if the power adapter is securely plugged into the unit and the wall outlet. Test the outlet with another device. Try a different power adapter if available.
VOX mode not working as expected	Voice not loud enough; receiving unit not in VOX mode or not pressing TALK.	Speak clearly and close to the microphone. Ensure the receiving unit is also in VOX mode for hands-free two-way communication, or that the user on the receiving end is pressing the TALK button to respond.
