INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides essential information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your Çamaşır Washing Machine Waste Water Drain Hose (3 Meter). Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and retain it for future reference. This hose is designed to efficiently discharge waste water from your washing machine to a suitable drainage point.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps for correct installation of the drain hose:

1. **Preparation:** Ensure your washing machine is unplugged from the power outlet and the water supply is turned off before beginning installation.
2. **Locate Drain Outlet:** Identify the waste water drain outlet on the back of your washing machine. This is

typically a ribbed or smooth spigot designed for hose connection.

- 3. Connect to Washing Machine:** Carefully push one end of the Çamaşır drain hose onto the washing machine's drain outlet. Ensure a snug fit. If necessary, use a hose clamp (not included) to secure the connection and prevent leaks, especially if the connection feels loose.

- 5. Secure to Drain:** Insert the end of the hose into the standpipe or secure it over the edge of a utility sink. Ensure the hose is positioned so it cannot easily dislodge during the washing cycle, which could cause flooding. The end of the hose should be above the water level in the drain to prevent backflow.
- 6. Check for Leaks:** Once installed, reconnect the washing machine to the power supply and turn on the water. Run a short rinse or drain cycle to check for any leaks at the connections. Address any leaks immediately by tightening connections or adjusting the hose.

OPERATING GUIDELINES

The Çamaşır drain hose is a passive component. Proper operation primarily involves ensuring it remains in good condition and correctly positioned:

- **Avoid Kinks:** Always ensure the hose is free from kinks or sharp bends that can restrict water flow and potentially damage the hose or the washing machine's pump.
- **Secure Positioning:** Verify that the hose remains securely connected to both the washing machine and the drainage point before each use, especially if the machine or hose has been moved.
- **Proper Drainage Height:** Ensure the end of the hose in the drain is at the correct height as specified by your washing machine manufacturer to prevent siphoning or backflow issues.

MAINTENANCE

Regular inspection and minor maintenance can extend the life of your drain hose:

- **Periodic Inspection:** Periodically inspect the entire length of the hose for any signs of wear, cracks, punctures, or hardening of the material. Pay close attention to the connection points.
- **Check for Blockages:** If you notice slow drainage or water backing up, check the hose for internal blockages caused by lint, debris, or foreign objects. Disconnect the hose and flush it with water if necessary.
- **Clean Connections:** Ensure the connection points on both the washing machine and the drain are clean and free of residue that could affect the seal.
- **Replace if Damaged:** If the hose shows significant signs of wear or damage, replace it immediately to prevent leaks and potential water damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are some common issues and their potential solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water not draining from washing machine.	Hose is kinked or bent. Internal blockage. Hose not properly connected to drain.	Straighten the hose. Disconnect and check for blockages, then flush. Ensure hose is correctly inserted into the drain.
Water leaking from hose connections.	Loose connection. Damaged hose end. Missing or loose hose clamp.	Tighten connections. Inspect hose ends for damage; replace if necessary. Install or tighten a hose clamp.
Water backing up from drain.	Drain itself is blocked. Hose inserted too far into drain, creating a siphon.	Clear the household drain. Adjust hose position in the drain according to washing machine manufacturer guidelines.
