Intex 28076E Deluxe Pool Ladder Instruction Manual

Model: 28076E

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Intex 28076E Deluxe Pool Ladder. Please read all instructions carefully before use to ensure proper setup and to prevent accidents. This ladder is designed for Intex pools with a wall height of up to 48 inches (122 cm).

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety is paramount. Adhere to all safety warnings and instructions to minimize the risk of injury.

- **Maximum Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 300 lbs (136 kg).
- **One Person At A Time:** Only one person should use the ladder at any given time.
- **No Diving or Jumping:** Never dive or jump from the ladder.
- **Adult Supervision:** Always supervise children when they are in or around the pool and using the ladder.
- **Removable Steps:** Utilize the removable steps feature to prevent unsupervised access to the pool, especially by children. Remove steps when the pool is not in use.
- **Secure Placement:** Ensure the ladder is placed on a firm, level surface and is stable before use.
- **Inspect Before Use:** Before each use, inspect the ladder for any loose, damaged, or missing parts. Do not use if damaged.
- **Slip-Resistant Steps:** The ladder features hi-impact slip-resistant steps. Always use caution when ascending or descending.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer support.

- Coated corrosion-resistant steel frame components
- Slip-resistant steps (typically 4 per side)
- Top platform
- Hardware for assembly (screws, nuts, caps)
- Instruction manual

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps for proper assembly of your pool ladder. It is recommended to have two adults for assembly.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, flat surface. Verify against the package contents list.
2. **Assemble Frame:** Connect the vertical and horizontal frame pieces according to the diagrams provided in the included paper manual. Ensure all connections are secure.
3. **Attach Steps:** Slide the slip-resistant steps onto the designated frame sections. Ensure they are oriented correctly for safe climbing.
4. **Install Top Platform:** Secure the top platform to the upper frame sections.
5. **Secure All Fasteners:** Tighten all screws and nuts firmly, but do not overtighten. Ensure all protective caps are in place.
6. **Position Ladder:** Place the assembled ladder against the pool wall, ensuring both sides are fully submerged in the water and resting firmly on the pool bottom or ground outside the pool.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To use the Intex Deluxe Pool Ladder safely and effectively:

- **Entering the Pool:** Face the ladder, hold onto the handrails, and carefully step down onto the steps one at a time until you reach the pool bottom.
- **Exiting the Pool:** Face the ladder, hold onto the handrails, and carefully step up onto the steps one at a time until you are out of the pool.
- **Removable Steps:** For enhanced safety, especially to prevent unsupervised access by children, the steps can be easily removed. To remove, lift and detach the steps from their base. To reattach, align the steps with the base, set them in place, and snap and lock them securely.

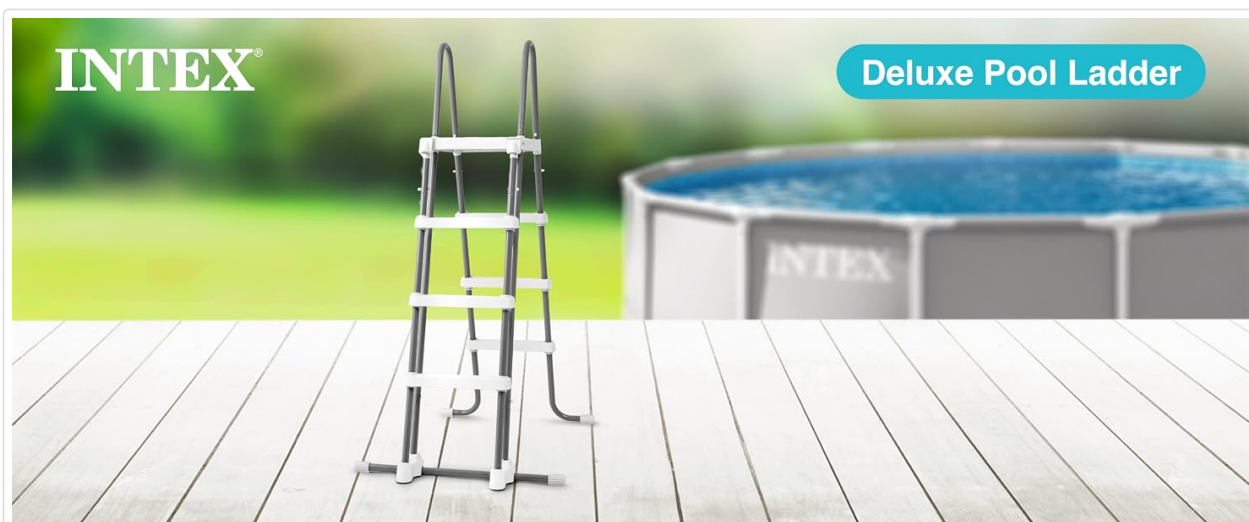


Image: A visual representation of the Intex Deluxe Pool Ladder, highlighting its design for easy climbing and the removable steps feature for safety.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your pool ladder and ensure continued safe operation.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the ladder regularly with mild soap and water. Rinse thoroughly to remove any chemical residue. Avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all parts for wear, corrosion, or damage. Pay close attention to step surfaces, frame connections, and rubber feet.
- **Corrosion Protection:** The steel frame is coated for corrosion resistance. However, prolonged exposure to harsh pool chemicals or saltwater may affect its longevity. Rinse the ladder with fresh water after each use, especially if using saltwater systems.
- **Storage:** During the off-season or when not in use for extended periods, disassemble the ladder, clean it thoroughly, and store it in a dry, protected area away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Intex Deluxe Pool Ladder, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ladder feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose connections; uneven ground; incorrect assembly.	Ensure all bolts and fasteners are securely tightened. Verify the ladder is on a firm, level surface. Re-check assembly steps.
Steps are difficult to remove or reattach.	Debris in locking mechanism; improper alignment.	Clean any debris from the step locking mechanisms. Ensure steps are aligned correctly before attempting to snap into place.
Corrosion appearing on frame.	Exposure to harsh chemicals or saltwater without rinsing.	Rinse the ladder with fresh water regularly, especially after exposure to pool chemicals or saltwater. Apply a rust-inhibiting spray if necessary.

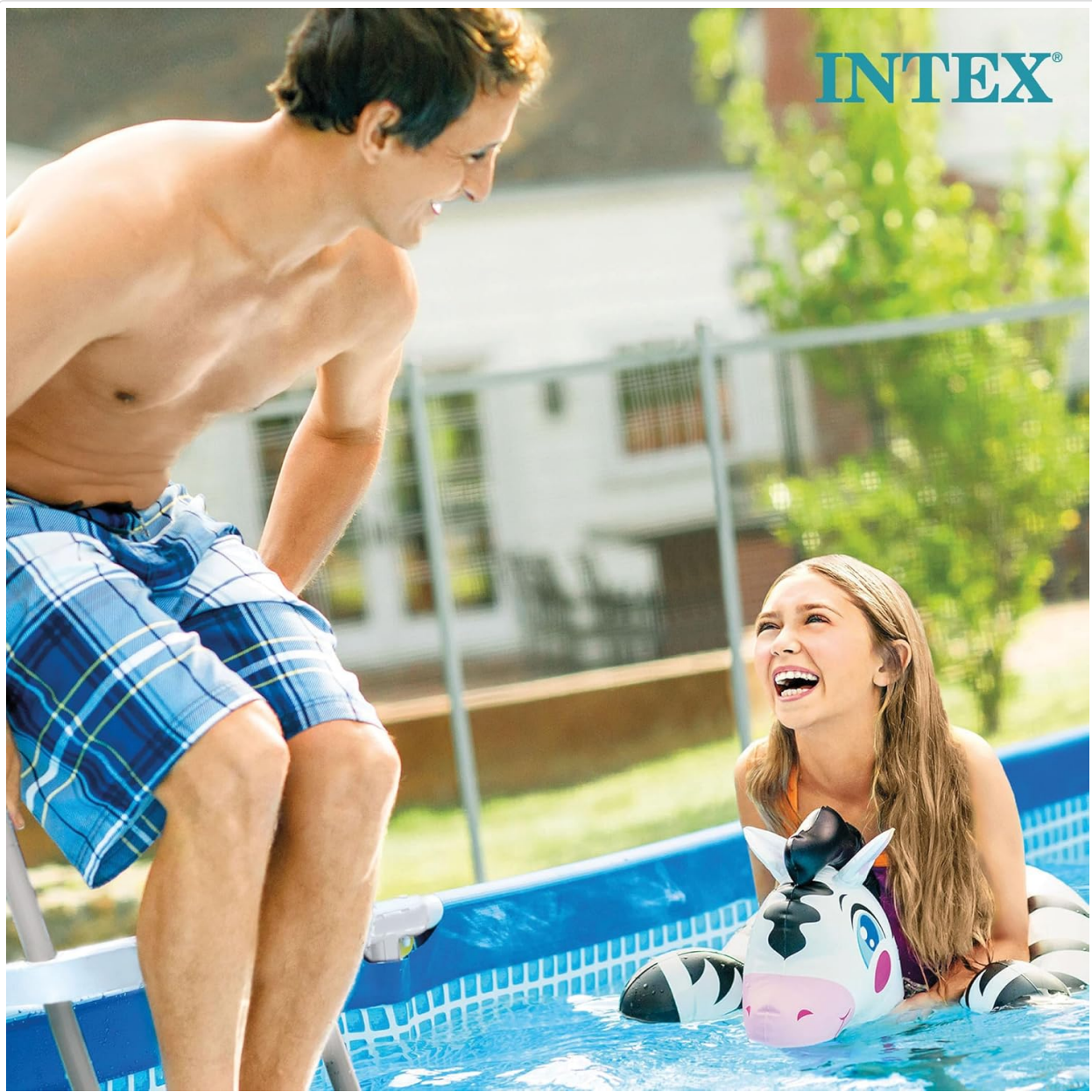
