# 1. Introduction and Overview

The Timex Expedition Scout 40mm Analog Watch is a robust and reliable timepiece designed for everyday wear and outdoor adventures. # 2. SETUP

# 2.1 Setting Time

- 1. Gently pull the crown (the knob on the side of the watch) out to its outermost position.
- 2. Rotate the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the hour and minute hands to the correct time.
- 3. Push the crown back in to its original position to start the watch.

# 2.2 Setting Date

- 1. Gently pull the crown out to its intermediate (middle) position. This position may feel slightly vague.
- 2. Rotate the crown to adjust the date in the date window (located at the 3 o'clock position).
- 3. Once the correct date is displayed, push the crown back in to its original position.

# 3. OPERATING FEATURES

# 3.1 INDIGLO® Night-Light

The INDIGLO® night-light illuminates the watch dial for easy readability in low-light conditions. To activate, simply press and hold the crown when it is in its normal (closed) position. The dial will light up with a soft blue glow.

### 3.2 24-Hour Time Display

In addition to the standard 12-hour clock, the watch dial includes smaller inner numerals for 24-hour (military) time, providing an alternative time reference.

#### 3.3 Water Resistance

The Timex Expedition Scout watch is water resistant to 50 meters (165 feet). This rating means it is generally suitable for short periods of recreational swimming, such as in a pool or shallow water. It is not recommended for diving, snorkeling, or high-impact water sports.

# 4. MAINTENANCE

#### 4.1 General Care

- Clean the watch regularly with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- Avoid exposing the watch to extreme temperatures (hot or cold) or sudden temperature changes.
- Protect the mineral glass crystal from impacts to prevent scratches.

# 4.2 Strap Care

The watch features a durable nylon strap with genuine leather trim. For optimal longevity:

- Avoid prolonged exposure to water for the leather components.
- Clean the nylon strap with mild soap and water, and allow it to air dry completely.

# **4.3 Battery Replacement**

This watch operates on a quartz movement and requires a battery. When the battery needs replacement, it is recommended to take the watch to an authorized Timex service center or a qualified watch repair professional to ensure proper sealing and water resistance integrity.

# 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

# 5.1 Audible Ticking Sound

Some users may notice an audible ticking sound from the watch's second hand. This is a characteristic of the watch's movement and is considered normal operation. It does not indicate a defect or malfunction.

# **5.2 Date Window Visibility**

The date window is compact and may be partially obscured by shadows in certain lighting conditions due to the angle of the watch face. Adjusting the viewing angle can improve readability.
