INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the Timex TIME Machines 35mm Camo Fast Wrap Kids Digital Watch. Please read this manual carefully to understand the functions and proper use of your watch. This digital watch is designed for durability and ease of use for children, featuring a digital display, chronograph, alarm, day-date calendar, and Indiglo backlight.

KEY FEATURES

- Adjustable Fast Wrap Strap: Black/gray striped 18mm double-layered nylon strap designed for a comfortable and secure fit, accommodating wrist circumferences up to 6 inches.
- Digital Display: Easy-to-read gray digital display.
- Indiglo Light-Up Dial: Provides illumination for visibility in low-light conditions.
- Chronograph: Stopwatch function for timing activities.
- Alarm: Programmable alarm function.
- Day-Date Calendar: Displays the current day and date.
- Water Resistance: Rated for 50 meters (165 feet), suitable for short periods of recreational swimming.
- Durable Construction: Features a black 35mm resin case with an acrylic lens.

Your watch has four buttons: SET (top left), MODE (bottom left), START/STOP (top right), and INDIGLO (bottom right).

1. Setting Time and Date

- 1. Press the MODE button repeatedly until the time setting mode is displayed (usually indicated by flashing digits).
- 2. Press the **SET** button to select the digit you wish to adjust (e.g., hours, minutes, year, month, day). The selected digit will flash.
- 3. Use the START/STOP button to increase the value of the flashing digit. Hold the button to advance rapidly.
- 4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 until all desired time and date settings are correct.
- 5. Press the **MODE** button to exit the setting mode and return to the normal time display.

2. Setting the Alarm

- 1. Press the MODE button until the alarm time is displayed (often indicated by "AL" or a bell icon).
- 2. Press the SET button to select the hour or minute digits for the alarm. The selected digit will flash.
- 3. Use the **START/STOP** button to adjust the alarm hour or minute.
- 4. Press the SET button again to toggle the alarm ON/OFF. An alarm icon will appear when the alarm is active.
- 5. Press the ${f MODE}$ button to exit the alarm setting mode.

OPERATING YOUR WATCH

1. Using Indiglo Night-Light

To illuminate the watch display in the dark, press the **INDIGLO** button (bottom right). The light will stay on as long as the button is held down.

2. Using the Chronograph (Stopwatch)

- 1. Press the MODE button until the chronograph mode is displayed (often indicated by "CHRO" or "STP").
- 2. Press the START/STOP button to start the stopwatch.
- 3. Press the **START/STOP** button again to pause the stopwatch.
- 4. To resume, press **START/STOP** again.
- 5. To reset the stopwatch to zero, press the **SET** button while the stopwatch is paused.
- 6. Press the MODE button to exit chronograph mode.

3. Alarm Function

When the alarm is set and the alarm time is reached, the watch will beep. To silence the alarm, press any button. If no button is pressed, the alarm will typically sound for a short duration and then stop automatically.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

1. Water Resistance

This watch is water resistant to 50 meters (165 feet). This means it is suitable for short periods of recreational swimming. It is **not** suitable for diving, snorkeling, or high-impact water sports. Do not press any buttons while the watch is submerged in water, as this can compromise the water resistance.

2. Battery Replacement

The watch uses 1 Lithium Metal battery (included). When the display dims or functions become erratic, it may be time to replace the battery. Battery replacement should ideally be performed by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and maintain water resistance.

3. Cleaning Your Watch

To clean your watch, wipe it with a soft, damp cloth. For the nylon strap, a mild soap solution can be used, followed by rinsing with clean water and air drying. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these can damage the watch case or strap.






Image: Back view of the watch, showing the adjustable Fast Wrap nylon strap.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Watch display is blank or dim.	Low or dead battery.	Replace the battery.
Time is incorrect.	Time needs to be reset.	Follow the "Setting Time and Date" instructions.
Buttons are unresponsive.	Temporary software glitch or low battery.	Try removing and reinserting the battery (if comfortable) or allow the battery to be replaced. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
Water inside the watch.	Water resistance compromised (e.g., buttons pressed underwater, seal damage).	Immediately take the watch to a qualified watch technician for inspection and repair. Do not attempt to dry it yourself.
