IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Electrical Safety: Ensure the dishwasher is properly grounded. Do not use extension cords.
- Water Safety: Turn off water supply before servicing. Check for leaks after installation.
- **Child Safety:** Keep children away from the dishwasher, especially when it is operating. Do not allow children to play inside or on the appliance.
- Chemical Safety: Use only detergents and rinse aids specifically designed for automatic dishwashers. Keep these products out of reach of children.
- Hot Surfaces: Be aware that the heating element and interior surfaces can be hot immediately after a wash cycle.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation is crucial for the safe and efficient operation of your GE Appliances dishwasher. It is highly recommended that installation be performed by a qualified installer.

Pre-Installation Checks:

- Location: Choose a location near a sink with easy access to water supply, drain, and electrical outlet.
- Clearances: Ensure adequate space for opening the door and for proper ventilation.
- Water Supply: Connect to a hot water line with a minimum temperature of 120°F (49°C).
- Drain Connection: Ensure proper air gap or high loop for drain hose to prevent backflow.
- Electrical Connection: Verify that the electrical supply meets the dishwasher's requirements (120V, 60Hz, dedicated circuit).

Leveling the Dishwasher:

Use the adjustable leveling legs to ensure the dishwasher is perfectly level. This prevents leaks and ensures proper door alignment.

Loading the Dishwasher:

- Upper Rack: Ideal for glasses, cups, and smaller bowls. Ensure items do not block spray arms.
- Lower Rack: Best for plates, larger bowls, and pots/pans.
- **Silverware Basket:** Place silverware with handles up for forks and spoons, and handles down for knives to ensure thorough cleaning and safety.

• Avoid overcrowding to allow water and detergent to reach all surfaces.

Adding Detergent and Rinse Aid:

- Use only automatic dishwasher detergent. Fill the main wash dispenser cup.
- Fill the rinse aid dispenser to the indicated level. Rinse aid helps with drying and prevents spots.

Selecting a Wash Cycle:

Press the "Cycle Select" button to cycle through available wash programs:

- **Heavy:** For heavily soiled dishes and pots/pans.
- AutoSense: Automatically adjusts wash time and water usage based on soil level.
- Light: For lightly soiled dishes and pre-rinsed items.
- Boost: Adds extra wash time and heat for stubborn soils.
- Sanitize: Uses higher water temperature to sanitize dishes, reducing bacteria.

Starting a Cycle:

Close the dishwasher door firmly. Press the "Start" button. The cycle will begin shortly.

Delay Start: Press "Delay Start" to postpone the cycle start time by 1-12 hours.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and performance of your dishwasher.

Cleaning the Filters:

- The dishwasher has a removable filter system. Regularly check and clean the coarse and fine filters to prevent food particle buildup and ensure proper drainage.
- Refer to the filter removal instructions in your full manual for detailed steps.

Cleaning the Interior:

- Wipe down the interior walls and door gasket periodically with a damp cloth to remove any residue.
- For mineral buildup or odors, run an empty cycle with a dishwasher cleaner or a cup of white vinegar placed in the lower rack.

Cleaning the Exterior:

- For stainless steel surfaces, use a soft cloth and a stainless steel cleaner. Always wipe in the direction of the grain.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Before calling for service, review this section for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dishes not clean	Improper loading, clogged spray arms, insufficient detergent, clogged filter.	Reload dishes correctly, clean spray arm nozzles, use recommended detergent amount, clean filter.
Dishwasher not draining	Clogged drain hose, clogged air gap, clogged filter, drain pump issue.	Check and clear drain hose/air gap, clean filter. If problem persists, contact service.
Leaking	Improper installation, damaged door gasket, too much detergent, unlevel appliance.	Verify installation, check door gasket for damage, reduce detergent, level dishwasher.
Dishwasher not starting	Door not latched, power supply issue, control lock engaged, cycle not selected.	Ensure door is fully closed, check circuit breaker, deactivate control lock, select a cycle.
