### **SETUP**

# 1. Charging Your Tablet

Before initial use, fully charge your Fire 7 tablet. Connect the included USB 2.0 cable to the tablet's micro-B port and the 5W power adapter. Plug the adapter into a wall outlet. A full charge typically takes approximately 4 hours.

### 2. Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the power button located on the side of the tablet until the Amazon logo appears.
- To Power Off: Press and hold the power button, then select "Power Off" from the on-screen options.

### 3. Initial Setup and Wi-Fi Connection

Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup. This includes selecting your language, connecting to a Wi-Fi network, and registering your device with an Amazon account. The tablet supports dual-band 802.11a/b/g/n Wi-Fi networks.

# 4. Inserting a microSD Card

To expand storage, insert a microSD card into the designated slot. The Fire 7 tablet supports up to 512 GB of additional storage. Some applications may require installation on internal storage.

# **Basic Navigation**

The Fire 7 tablet features a 7-inch IPS touchscreen display. Navigate by tapping, swiping, and pinching gestures. The home screen provides access to your apps, content, and settings.






Image: An Amazon Fire 7 Tablet displaying an email inbox, showing several unread messages.



# **Camera Functionality**

The Fire 7 tablet is equipped with 2 MP front and rear-facing cameras, capable of 720p HD video recording.

### **Audio**

The device includes an integrated speaker and a 3.5 mm stereo jack for headphones. Bluetooth is built-in, supporting A2DP compatible stereo headphones, speakers, microphones, and LE accessories.

# **Accessibility Features**

- VoiceView screen reader: Provides text-to-speech or refreshable braille display access for visually impaired users.
