5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your HyperX Pulsefire FPS Pro Gaming Mouse, follow these maintenance tips:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the mouse regularly. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild cleaning solution. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Sensor Care:** Keep the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse clean and free from dust or debris. Use a cotton swab or compressed air if necessary.
- **Cable Management:** Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling on the USB cable to prevent damage.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the mouse in a clean, dry environment away from extreme temperatures.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your HyperX Pulsefire FPS Pro Gaming Mouse, try the following solutions:

- **Mouse Not Responding:**
 - Ensure the USB cable is securely plugged into a working USB port.
 - Try plugging the mouse into a different USB port or another computer to rule out port or system issues.
 - Restart your computer.
- **Inaccurate Tracking/Jittery Cursor:**
 - Clean the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse.
 - Ensure you are using the mouse on a clean, uniform surface (preferably a mousepad).
 - Check DPI settings in HyperX NGenuity software; reset to default if needed.
- **Buttons Not Working:**
 - Verify button assignments in HyperX NGenuity software.
 - Test the mouse on another computer to determine if the issue is hardware or software related.
- **RGB Lighting Issues:**
 - Ensure HyperX NGenuity software is running and lighting effects are configured correctly.
 - Update the mouse firmware via the NGenuity software.
