1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper use and care of your Apple iPad (6th Generation, 2018) Wi-Fi 128GB. Please read this guide thoroughly to understand the device's functionalities and ensure optimal performance. This iPad is a versatile tablet designed for various tasks, including browsing the internet, consuming media, and running applications.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

2.1 Key Features

- 9.7-inch Multi-Touch Retina Display with 2048 x 1536 resolution (264 ppi)

3. SETUP

3.1 Initial Power On and Charging

1. **Charge the iPad:** Connect the included USB power adapter and Lightning to USB cable to your iPad and a power outlet. Allow the device to charge for at least 30 minutes before initial use.
2. **Power On:** Press and hold the Top button (located on the top right edge) until the Apple logo appears.

3.2 Setup Assistant

Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup:

1. **Select Language and Region:** Choose your preferred language and country or region.
2. **Quick Start:** If you have another iOS device, you can use Quick Start to set up your new iPad automatically.
3. **Connect to Wi-Fi:** Select your Wi-Fi network and enter the password.
4. **Data & Privacy:** Review Apple's Data & Privacy information.
5. **Touch ID:** Set up Touch ID for fingerprint authentication.
6. **Create a Passcode:** Set a 6-digit passcode for security.
7. **Transfer Apps & Data:** Choose to restore from iCloud Backup, Mac or PC, or set up as a new iPad.
8. **Apple ID:** Sign in with your Apple ID or create a new one. This is essential for downloading apps, using iCloud, and other Apple services.
9. **Siri, Screen Time, and Analytics:** Configure these features as desired.
10. **True Tone Display:** Enable or disable True Tone.
11. **Welcome to iPad:** Tap 'Get Started' to begin using your iPad.

4. OPERATING YOUR iPad

4.1 Basic Gestures

- **Tap:** Select an item or activate a button.
- **Swipe:** Scroll through content or navigate between screens.
- **Pinch:** Zoom in or out on photos, maps, or web pages.
- **Touch and Hold:** Access contextual menus or rearrange app icons.

4.2 Home Button and Touch ID

- **Single Press:** Return to the Home screen.
- **Double Press:** Open the App Switcher to view recently used apps.
- **Touch and Hold:** Activate Siri.
- **Touch ID:** Place your registered finger on the Home button to unlock your iPad or authorize purchases.

4.3 Control Center and Notification Center

- **Control Center:** Swipe down from the top-right corner of the screen to access quick settings like Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, brightness, and volume.
- **Notification Center:** Swipe down from the top-center of the screen to view recent notifications.

4.4 App Store and Applications

Access the App Store icon on your Home screen to browse, purchase, and download applications. Ensure you are signed in with your Apple ID.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Battery Care

- Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Keep the battery charged between 20% and 80% for optimal longevity.
- Perform a full charge cycle (0% to 100%) occasionally.

5.2 Cleaning Your iPad

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean your iPad. Avoid abrasive materials, aerosols, solvents, or ammonia-based cleaners. For the screen, a slightly damp cloth is sufficient. Do not submerge the device in any liquids.

5.3 Software Updates

Regularly check for and install iOS updates to ensure your iPad has the latest features, security patches, and

performance improvements. Go to **Settings > General > Software Update**.

5.4 Backup and Restore

Regularly back up your iPad to iCloud or a computer to prevent data loss. This can be done via **Settings > [Your Name] > iCloud > iCloud Backup** or by connecting to a computer and using Finder (macOS Catalina or later) or iTunes (macOS Mojave or earlier, or Windows).

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1 Common Issues and Solutions

- **iPad is unresponsive or frozen:** Press and hold the Top button and the Home button simultaneously until the Apple logo appears.
- **Wi-Fi connectivity issues:** Go to **Settings > Wi-Fi**, turn Wi-Fi off and then on again. If the issue persists, try resetting network settings via **Settings > General > Transfer or Reset iPad > Reset > Reset Network Settings**.
- **Apps crashing or not responding:** Close the app from the App Switcher (double-press Home button and swipe up on the app) and reopen it. If the problem continues, try restarting your iPad.
- **Battery drains quickly:** Review battery usage in **Settings > Battery** to identify power-hungry apps. Adjust screen brightness, disable background app refresh for non-essential apps, and ensure your iPad is running the latest iOS version.
- **Touch ID not working:** Ensure your finger is clean and dry. Re-register your fingerprints in **Settings > Touch ID & Passcode**.

Take a Live Photo. (on supported models) A Live Photo captures what happens just before and after you take your photo, along with the audio. Choose Photo, tap  to turn on Live Photos (yellow is on), then tap the Shutter button. Live photos are marked with "Live" in the corner. You can edit Live Photos and add filters to them in the Photos app.


Live Photos works with the rear camera and the FaceTime camera.

Take Burst shots. (on supported models) With the camera in Photo or Square mode, touch and hold the Shutter button to take rapid-fire photos in bursts. Lift your finger to stop. The counter shows how many photos you've taken. To save the suggested photo and select the photos you want to save, tap the burst thumbnail, then tap Select.
