INTRODUCTION

GETTING STARTED

Key and Ignition

Familiarize yourself with the warning lights and indicators on your dashboard. Consult the manual for

OPERATING THE VEHICLE

Transmission

The 2014 Camry features an automatic transmission. Use the shift lever to select 'P' (Park), 'R' (Reverse), 'N' (Neutral), or 'D' (Drive). For manual shifting, move the lever to 'S' (Sport) mode and use the paddle shifters or shift lever to change gears.

Lights and Wipers

- The headlight switch controls the headlights, parking lights, and daytime running lights.
- The wiper stalk controls the front and rear wipers, as well as the washer fluid.

Climate Control

Adjust the temperature, fan speed, and air distribution using the climate control panel. Some models feature dual-zone climate control for individual temperature settings.

Audio System

Your Camry is equipped with an audio system. Refer to the dedicated section in the full owner's manual for detailed instructions on radio, CD player, auxiliary input, and Bluetooth connectivity.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is crucial for the longevity and performance of your Camry.

Routine Checks

- **Engine Oil:** Check oil level regularly and change according to the maintenance schedule.
- **Tire Pressure:** Maintain correct tire pressure as specified on the driver's side door jamb.
- **Brake Fluid:** Check fluid level periodically.
- **Windshield Washer Fluid:** Keep the reservoir filled.

Service Schedule

TROUBLESHOOTING
