## SETUP

### Initial Charging of Your HALO Bolt

Before first use, fully charge your HALO Bolt 58830 ACDC. Use the provided AC Wall Charger. Plug the charger into the "INPUT" port on the HALO Bolt and then into a standard wall outlet. The LED indicator lights will illuminate to show the charging progress. All four lights will be solid green when fully charged.

## **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

### **Jump Starting a Vehicle**

The HALO Bolt 58830 ACDC can jump-start standard cars, SUVs, and trucks. Follow these steps carefully:

1. Ensure your HALO Bolt is fully charged.
2. Connect the jumper cables to the HALO Bolt's jump-start port.
3. Attach the red clamp to the positive (+) terminal of your vehicle's battery.
4. Attach the black clamp to a clean, unpainted metal part of your vehicle's engine block or chassis (ground point), away from the battery.
5. Press the "Jump Start" button on the HALO Bolt. Wait for a solid green light, indicating a safety check is in process.
6. Once the light is solid green, start your vehicle.
7. After the vehicle starts, immediately disconnect the jumper cables from the HALO Bolt, then from the vehicle's

battery (black clamp first, then red clamp).

## Charging Electronic Devices

The HALO Bolt 58830 ACDC can charge a wide range of electronic devices:

- **USB Devices:** Use the two 5V/2.4A USB charging outputs to power smartphones, tablets, and other USB-powered devices. Simply connect your device's USB cable to the HALO Bolt.
- **AC Devices:** The 120V AC wall outlet allows you to power laptops, small appliances, and other devices requiring a standard wall plug. Press the AC power button to activate the outlet.

### **Using the Emergency Floodlight**

The HALO Bolt features a built-in LED floodlight for emergency situations or when extra illumination is needed. Press the floodlight power button to turn it on or off.

## MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your HALO Bolt 58830 ACDC:

- Recharge the unit every 3 months when not in use to maintain battery health.
- Store the unit in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Clean the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Keep all ports and connections free from dust and debris.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your HALO Bolt 58830 ACDC, consider the following:

- **Unit not turning on:** Ensure the unit is charged. Connect it to the AC wall charger and allow it to charge for a few hours.

- **Vehicle not jump starting:**

- Check that the jumper cables are securely connected to both the HALO Bolt and the vehicle's battery terminals/ground point.
- Ensure the "Jump Start" button is pressed and a solid green light appears.
- Verify that the vehicle's battery terminals are clean and free of corrosion.
- If the red light flashes, check for reverse polarity connection and correct it.

- **Devices not charging via USB/AC:**

- Ensure the HALO Bolt has sufficient charge.
- Verify that the correct power button (blue for USB, AC button for AC outlet) is activated.
- Check that your device's charging cable is properly connected and functional.
