Vileda Turbo Smart Microfiber Wet Mop Instruction Manual

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Vileda Turbo Smart Microfiber Wet Mop and Bucket Set (Model: Smart Sistema) is designed for efficient floor cleaning. This system includes a mop head, a bucket with a pedal-activated wringing mechanism, and a telescopic handle. The microfiber mop head is effective for various floor types and is machine washable.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Assemble the Handle:** Connect the sections of the telescopic handle by twisting them clockwise until secure. Extend the handle to a comfortable length by twisting counter-clockwise to loosen, extending, and then twisting clockwise to tighten.
2. **Attach the Mop Head:** Align the mop head with the base of the handle. Press firmly until it clicks into place. Ensure the mop head is securely attached before use.
3. **Prepare the Bucket:** Place the bucket on a flat, stable surface. Fill the bucket with water up to the indicated "MAX" line. Add your preferred floor cleaning solution if desired.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Wet the Mop:** Dip the microfiber mop head into the water in the bucket, ensuring it is fully saturated.
2. **Wring the Mop:** Place the wet mop head into the wringer basket. Hold the handle upright and press the foot pedal repeatedly to spin the mop head. The more you press the pedal, the drier the mop head will become, allowing for control over wetness for different floor types.

3. **Mop the Floor:** Begin mopping your floor. The triangular head design allows for effective cleaning in corners and along edges.

MAINTENANCE

Mop Head Care:

- **Washing:** The microfiber mop head is machine washable. Remove the mop head from the handle and place it in a washing machine. Wash with similar colors at a maximum temperature of 60°C (140°F). Do not use bleach or fabric softener.

- **Drying:** Air dry the mop head. Do not tumble dry.
- **Replacement:** For optimal cleaning performance, it is recommended to replace the mop head every 6 months.

Bucket Care:

- **Cleaning:** After each use, empty the dirty water from the bucket. Rinse the bucket thoroughly with clean water.
- **Storage:** Store the bucket and mop in a dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mop head not spinning effectively.	Mop head not properly seated in the wringer basket, or mechanism is jammed.	Ensure the mop head is correctly positioned in the wringer. Check for any debris obstructing the spinning mechanism. If the issue persists, the spin mechanism might be faulty (refer to warranty).
Mop head detaches during use.	Mop head not securely attached to the handle.	Re-attach the mop head, ensuring it clicks firmly into place.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Floor remains too wet after mopping.	Mop head not wrung out sufficiently.	Press the foot pedal more times to achieve a drier mop head before mopping.
