### 1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Pyle 40 Inch LED TV with Built-in CD/DVD Player, Model PTVDLED40.5. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product and retain it for future reference.

# **4.1 Front View**

- HDMI (x3): High-Definition Multimedia Interface inputs for digital audio/video.
- YPbPr (Component Video): Analog video input (green, blue, red) for high-quality analog video.
- RCA (L/R Audio, Video): Analog audio (white, red) and composite video (yellow) inputs.
- VGA/PC: Video Graphics Array input for connecting a computer.
- PC Audio: Audio input for VGA connection.
- RF (Antenna): Input for connecting an antenna or cable TV.
- Optical (Digital) Audio Out: Digital audio output for connecting to a soundbar or receiver.
- **Headphones:** 3.5mm audio output for headphones.
- USB: For service or media playback (check manual for specific functionality).
- Coaxial: Digital audio output.

# 4.4 Built-in CD/DVD Player

The TV features a side-loading CD/DVD player. Insert discs gently into the slot located on the side of the television.

# 5. SETUP

# 5.1 Attaching the Base Stands

- 1. Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
- 2. Align each base stand with the corresponding slots on the bottom of the TV.
- 3. Secure each stand using the provided screws. Ensure they are tightened firmly.

# **5.2 Wall Mounting (Optional)**

The TV is VESA mounting compatible (200mm x 200mm). Remove the base stands if you intend to wall mount the television. Use a VESA-compatible wall mount kit (sold separately) and follow the instructions provided with the wall mount.

WARNING: Wall mounting should be performed by qualified personnel to prevent injury or damage.

#### **5.3 Connecting Power**

- 1. Connect the power cord to the AC input on the back of the TV.
- 2. Plug the other end of the power cord into a standard electrical outlet (100-240V, 50/60Hz).

# **5.4 Connecting External Devices**

Refer to the "Rear Panel Connections" section for port locations.

• HDMI Devices: Connect HDMI cables from your devices (e.g., Blu-ray player, game console) to the

HDMI ports on the TV.

- Component Video (YPbPr) Devices: Connect component video cables (green, blue, red) and RCA audio cables (white, red) from your device to the corresponding inputs.
- Composite Video (RCA) Devices: Connect composite video cable (yellow) and RCA audio cables (white, red) from your device to the corresponding inputs.
- Antenna/Cable: Connect an RF coaxial cable from your antenna or cable wall outlet to the RF input.
- **PC Connection:** Connect a VGA cable from your computer to the VGA port and an audio cable from your computer's audio output to the PC Audio input.

# 6. OPERATION

#### 6.1 Power On/Off

Press the **POWER** button on the remote control or the side panel to turn the TV on or off.

#### **6.2 Remote Control**

Insert two 'AAA' batteries into the remote control, observing polarity. Point the remote control towards the TV's IR sensor.

- POWER: Turns the TV on/off.
- INPUT: Selects the input source.
- VOL +/-: Adjusts volume.

- CH +/-: Changes channels.
- MENU: Opens the main menu.
- Navigation Buttons (Up/Down/Left/Right/OK): Navigate menu options.
- EXIT/BACK: Exits current menu or goes back.
- MUTE: Mutes/unmutes sound.
- DVD Controls: Play, Pause, Stop, Fast Forward, Rewind, Next/Previous Track.
- V-CHIP: Accesses V-Chip settings for parental control.
- CC (Closed Caption): Toggles closed captions on/off.
- SLEEP: Sets the sleep timer.

# 6.3 Selecting Input Source

Press the **INPUT** button on the remote control to cycle through available input sources (TV, HDMI1, HDMI2, HDMI3, YPbPr, AV, VGA, DVD).

# 6.4 Using the Built-in CD/DVD Player

- 1. Ensure the TV is powered on.
- 2. Gently insert a compatible disc (DVD, DVD+/-R, DVD+/-RW, CD, CD-R, CD-RW, JPEG) into the side-loading slot with the label facing up.
- 3. The TV should automatically switch to DVD mode. If not, press the NPUT button and select "DVD".
- 4. Use the DVD control buttons on the remote control (Play, Pause, Stop, etc.) to manage playback.

#### 6.5 Menu Functions

Press the **MENU** button to access the on-screen display (OSD) menu. Use the navigation buttons to select and adjust settings.

- **Picture Settings:** Adjust brightness, contrast, color, sharpness, and picture modes (Standard, Dynamic, Movie, User).
- Sound Settings: Adjust bass, treble, balance, and sound modes (Standard, Music, Movie, User).
- Channel Settings: Auto scan for channels, manual tuning, channel list.
- Time Settings: Set current time, sleep timer, auto power off.
- **Option Settings:** Language, V-Chip (parental control), Closed Caption, display modes (16:9, 4:3, Zoom, Cinema).

# 7. MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning the Screen: Gently wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, dampen the cloth with a small amount of screen cleaner specifically designed for electronics. Do not spray cleaner directly onto the screen.
- Cleaning the Cabinet: Wipe the TV cabinet with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the ventilation openings on the back of the TV are not blocked to prevent overheating.
- Power Cord: Regularly check the power cord for any damage. If damaged, discontinue use and contact qualified service personnel.

# 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cord not connected; no power from outlet.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in. Check if the outlet is working by plugging in another device.
No picture, but sound is present	Incorrect input source selected; loose video cable.	Press the <b>INPUT</b> button to select the correct source. Check video cable connections.
No sound, but picture is present	Volume is muted or too low; incorrect audio cable connection.	Press the <b>MUTE</b> button or increase volume. Check audio cable connections.
Remote control not working	Batteries are dead or incorrectly inserted; obstruction between remote and TV.	Replace batteries. Ensure correct polarity. Remove any obstructions. Point remote directly at the TV's IR sensor.
DVD player not reading disc	Disc is dirty, scratched, or incompatible format; disc inserted incorrectly.	Clean the disc. Try a different, known-good disc. Ensure disc is inserted with the label facing up.
Poor picture quality from antenna	Weak signal; antenna not positioned correctly.	Adjust antenna position. Perform an auto channel scan. Consider a stronger antenna or signal amplifier.
