# AL-HARAMEEN Azan Clock HA-4008 User Manual

Model: HA-4008

## 1. OVERVIEW

---

The AL-HARAMEEN HA-4008 Azan Clock is a versatile digital LED clock designed to display prayer times for most cities worldwide. It supports five different prayer time calculation calendars and offers various features to assist with daily prayer schedules.

Key features include:

- Five Azan Alarms with complete Azan sound.
- City setting by international dialing telephone code.
- Hijri and Gregorian calendar display.
- Daily and optional weekend alarm settings.
- Temperature display.
- Snooze option.
- Daylight saving time option.

## 2. SETUP

Before initial use, ensure the clock is powered correctly. The clock operates primarily via the provided power adapter. **Note:** Batteries are intended for time memory backup only and should not be relied upon for continuous operation.

1. **Connect Power:** Connect the power adapter to the clock's power input and then plug it into a suitable

electrical outlet.

2. **Initial Power On:** The clock display should illuminate.
3. **City Setting:** Use the remote control or the buttons on the clock to navigate to the city setting menu. Input your city's international dialing telephone code to set the correct prayer times. Refer to the separate quick start guide for a list of city codes.
4. **Prayer Time Adjustment:** For locations on the outskirts of adopted cities, you can manually modify the difference in prayer times to ensure accuracy. Consult the detailed instructions in the full manual for precise adjustment steps.

### 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The HA-4008 clock provides comprehensive prayer time displays and alarms. Use the remote control or the buttons on the clock to navigate through the menus and adjust settings.

- **Prayer Alarms:** The clock features five Azan alarms for all daily prayers, with complete Azan sound playback. Use the volume control to adjust the sound level.

- **Daily and Weekend Alarms:** Set specific daily alarms and choose optional weekend alarms according to your schedule.
- **Azan Sound Control:** The Azan sound can be turned on or off as desired through the settings menu.
- **Snooze Function:** A snooze option is available for alarms. When an alarm sounds, activate the snooze function to temporarily silence it.
- **Calendar Display:** The clock displays both Hijri and Gregorian calendars simultaneously.
- **Daylight Saving Time:** An option to adjust for Daylight Saving Time is included. Enable or disable this feature as required by your region.
- **Temperature Display:** The current ambient temperature is displayed on the clock.

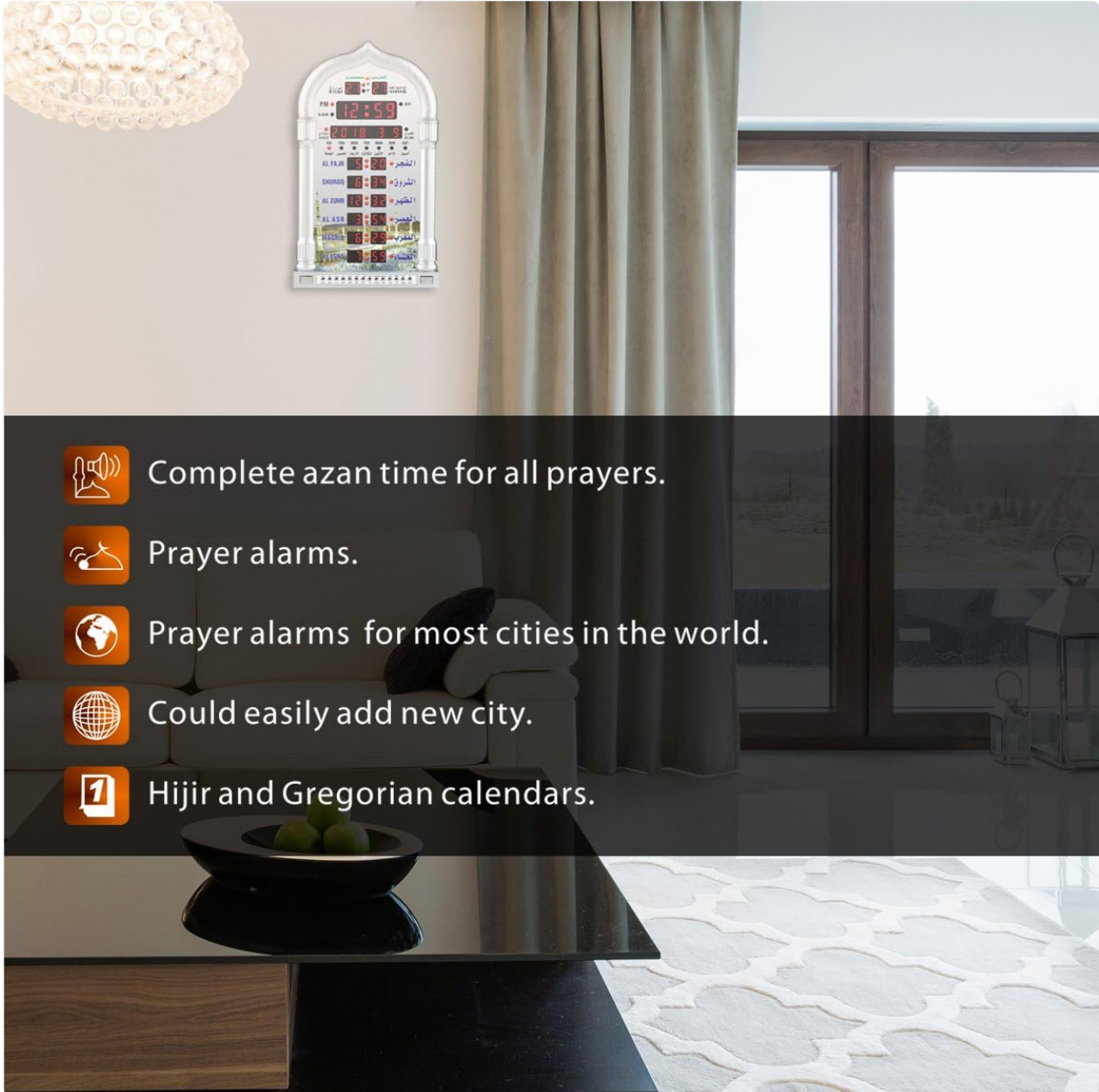


Image 4: Detailed view of the clock's display with various indicators.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and proper functioning of your AL-HARAMEEN Azan Clock, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the clock surface with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, solvents, or excessive moisture, which can damage the display or casing.

- **Power:** Always use the original power adapter provided with the clock. Disconnect power during electrical storms or when the clock will not be in use for extended periods.
- **Environment:** Keep the clock in a dry environment, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity. Ensure adequate ventilation if wall-mounted.
- **Battery Replacement:** If the clock loses time settings after a power outage, the internal backup batteries may need replacement. Refer to the full manual for instructions on how to safely replace them.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your AL-HARAMEEN Azan Clock, consider the following common solutions:

- **Clock Not Displaying:** Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the clock and a working power outlet. Check if the power outlet is functional by plugging in another device.
- **Incorrect Prayer Times:** Verify that the correct city code and prayer time calculation method are selected in the settings. Adjust any time differences as needed. Refer to the setup section for guidance.
- **No Azan Sound:** Check the volume settings on the clock or remote control. Ensure the Azan sound is not set to 'off' in the clock's settings menu.
- **Buttons Unresponsive:** If using the remote control, ensure its batteries are fresh and there are no obstructions between the remote and the clock. For clock buttons, ensure they are not physically stuck or damaged.
- **Inaccurate Temperature:** Ensure the clock is not placed near heat sources or in direct sunlight, which can affect temperature readings.
