3. SETUP

3.1 Attaching the TV Stands

To place the TV on a flat surface, attach the two TV feet to the bottom of the television. Ensure the feet are securely fastened to provide stability.

3.2 Wall Mounting (Optional)

Your ATYME TV is VESA compatible for wall mounting. Refer to the wall mount kit instructions for proper installation. Ensure adequate ventilation around the TV when wall-mounted.

3.3 Connecting Power

Plug the power cable into the TV's power input and then into a standard electrical outlet. The TV will enter standby mode.

3.4 Connecting External Devices

Connect your external devices (e.g., cable box, DVD player, gaming console) to the appropriate input ports on the TV. Refer to the 'Connectivity' section for port details.

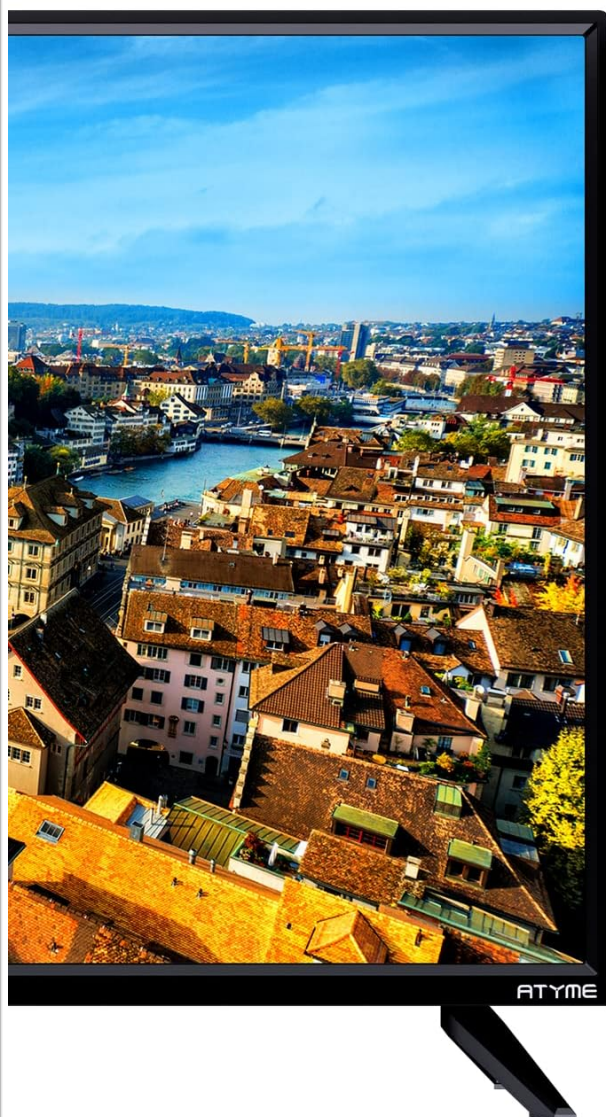


Figure 3.3: Visual representation of connecting various devices such as laptops, gaming consoles, and media players to the TV via HDMI ports.

4. OPERATING THE TV

4.1 Remote Control Functions

The included remote control allows you to manage all TV functions. Insert the provided batteries into the remote control before use. Familiarize yourself with the buttons for power, volume, channel selection, input source, and menu navigation.

4.2 Power On/Off

Press the **POWER** button on the remote control or the TV to turn the television on or off.

4.3 Input Source Selection

Press the **SOURCE** button on the remote control to cycle through available input sources (HDMI 1, HDMI 2, HDMI 3 (ARC), VGA, AV, USB, DTV/ATV). Select the input corresponding to your connected device.

4.4 Picture and Audio Settings

Access the TV's menu to adjust picture settings (Brightness, Contrast, Color, Sharpness, Picture Mode) and audio settings

(Volume, Sound Mode). These adjustments can enhance your viewing and listening experience.

4.5 Channel Scan

If connecting an antenna or cable directly to the TV, navigate to the 'Channel' menu and perform an 'Auto Scan' to find available channels.

5. CONNECTIVITY

The ATYME 320GM5HD TV offers a variety of ports for connecting external devices:

- **HDMI Inputs (x3):** Connect high-definition devices such as Blu-ray players, gaming consoles, and streaming devices. One HDMI port supports Audio Return Channel (ARC).
- **USB Input (x1):** For playing media files from a USB drive.
- **VGA Input (x1):** Connect a computer or laptop.
- **Composite (AV) Input (x1):** Connect older devices using RCA cables (yellow for video, red/white for audio).
- **Antenna/Cable Input (x1):** For connecting an antenna or cable TV signal.
- **PC Audio Input (x1):** For audio from a PC connected via VGA.
- **Optical Audio Output (x1):** For connecting to a soundbar or home theater system for digital audio.
- **Headphone Analog Audio Output (x1):** For connecting headphones or external speakers.

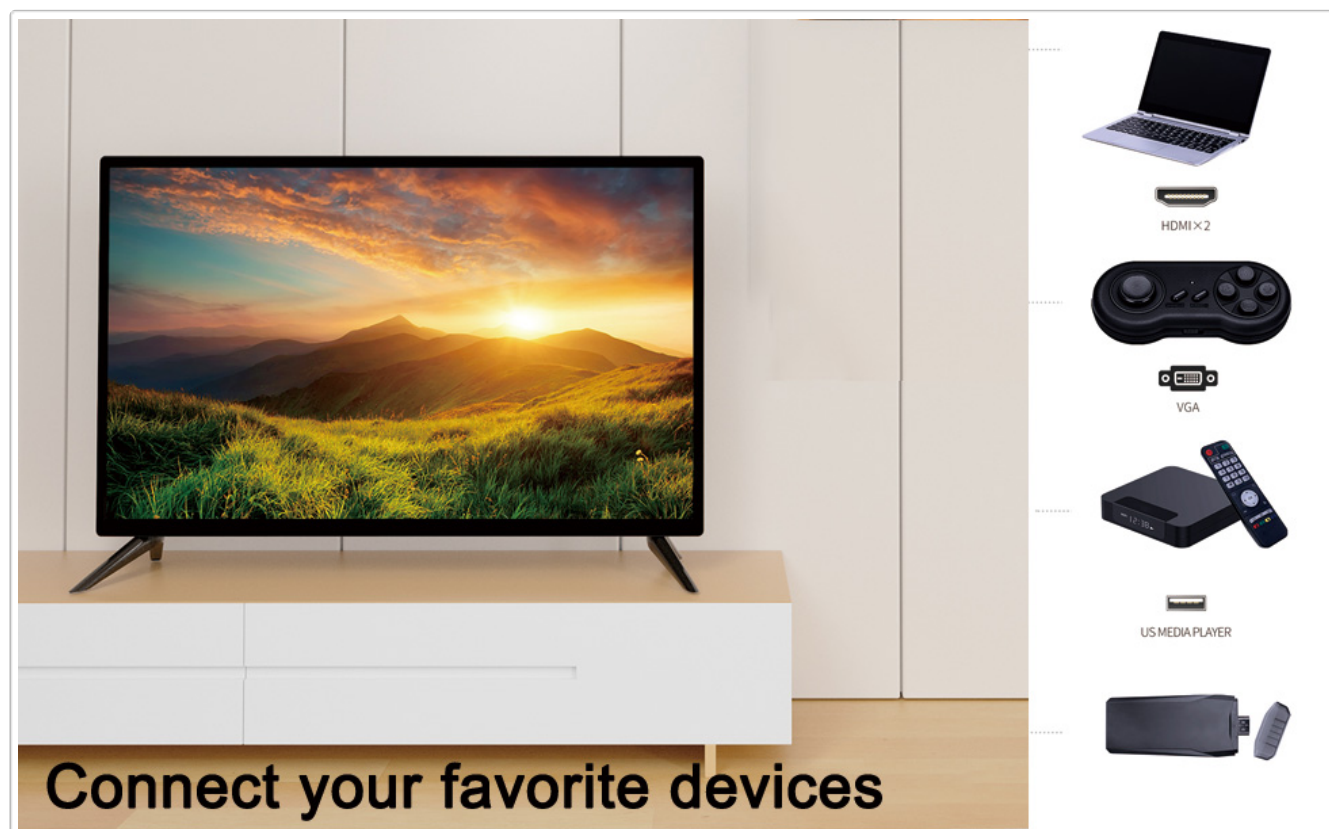


Figure 5.1: Illustration of various devices connecting to the TV's input ports, including HDMI, VGA, and USB.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning the TV

Always unplug the TV before cleaning. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the screen and cabinet. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner specifically designed for electronics. Avoid using alcohol, benzene, thinners, or other volatile substances.

6.2 General Care

Avoid exposing the TV to direct sunlight, high temperatures, or high humidity. Do not block ventilation openings. Keep the TV away from sources of strong electromagnetic interference.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV, refer to the following common problems and solutions before contacting support.

Problem	Possible Solution
No power	Ensure the power cable is securely plugged into the TV and a working electrical outlet. Check if the outlet has power.
No picture, but sound is present	Check the input source selection. Ensure the external device is powered on and connected correctly.
No sound, but picture is present	Check the volume level and ensure the TV is not muted. Verify audio cable connections for external devices.
Remote control not working	Check and replace the batteries. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor.
Poor picture quality	Adjust picture settings (brightness, contrast, sharpness). Check the quality of the input signal or source device.

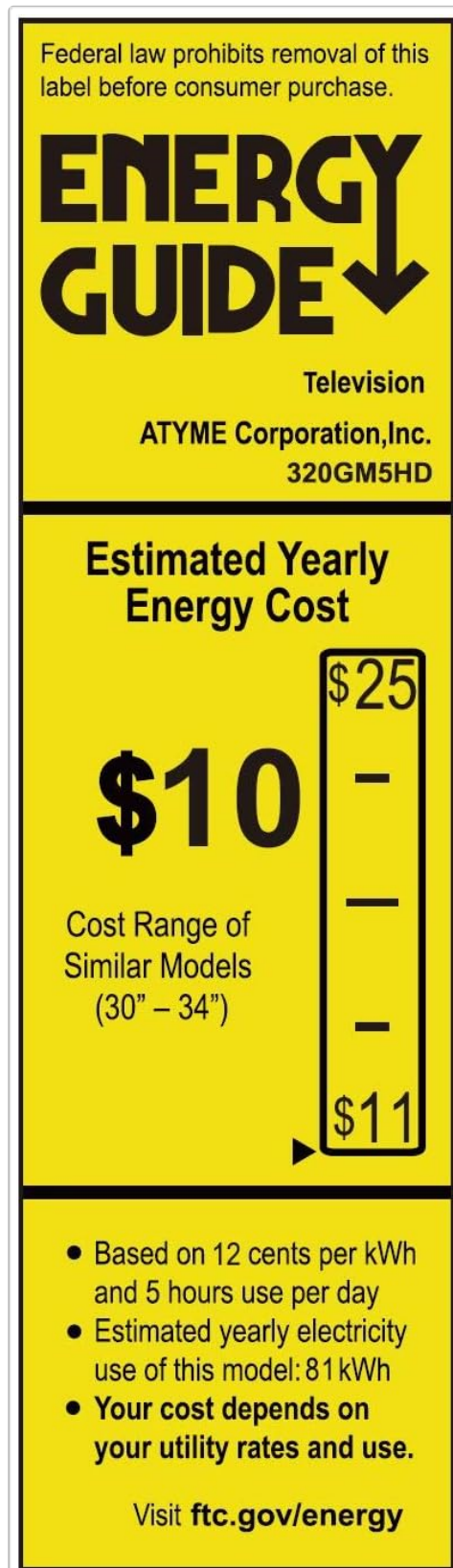





Figure 8.1: Energy Guide label for the ATYME 320GM5HD television, detailing estimated yearly energy cost and consumption.
