INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Audiovox ELEAUDAX80EXT Wireless Extension. This device is designed to expand the functionality of compatible Audiovox phone models, specifically the AX8001, AX8001E, and AX8101AM, by providing an additional wireless handset.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please verify that all items are present in the package before proceeding with the setup.

- Audiovox ELEAUDAX80EXT Wireless Extension Unit
- Power Adapter (if applicable)
- Rechargeable Battery (pre-installed or separate)

SETUP

1. **Charge the Battery:** If the battery is not pre-installed, insert it into the extension unit according to the markings. Place the extension unit on its charging cradle (if included) or connect the power adapter directly to the unit and a power outlet. Allow the unit to charge for at least 12-16 hours before initial use.
2. **Register the Extension:**
 - Ensure your main Audiovox phone base (AX8001, AX8001E, or AX8101AM) is powered on.
 - On the main phone base, locate and press the "Register" or "Page" button. Hold it until the indicator light on the base begins to flash (refer to your main phone's manual for exact instructions).
 - While the base is in registration mode, on the ELEAUDAX80EXT extension unit, navigate to the "Menu" and select "Register Handset" or a similar option. Follow the on-screen prompts.
 - Once registration is successful, the extension unit will display a confirmation message, and the indicator light on the base will stop flashing.
3. **Test Connection:** Make a test call from the extension unit to ensure proper functionality.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Making a Call

1. Pick up the handset or press the **TALK** button.
2. Dial the desired phone number.
3. Press the **TALK** button again or place the handset back on the cradle to end the call.

Answering a Call

- When the phone rings, pick up the handset or press the **TALK** button.
- To end the call, press the **END** button or place the handset back on the cradle.

Intercom Function (if supported by base unit)

- Press the **INTERCOM** button.
- Dial the number of the extension you wish to call (e.g., "2" for the second handset).
- Press **TALK** to initiate the intercom call.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Battery Care:** For optimal battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Keep the unit on its charger when not in use.
- **Storage:** If storing the unit for an extended period, remove the battery and store it in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution

Problem	Solution
No dial tone / Cannot make calls	<p>Ensure the extension is properly registered to the base unit.</p> <p>Check if the main phone line is active.</p> <p>Verify the battery is charged.</p>
Handset not charging	<p>Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to the unit and the power outlet.</p> <p>Clean the charging contacts on both the handset and the cradle with a dry cloth.</p> <p>Verify the power outlet is functional.</p>
Poor call quality / Static	<p>Move closer to the main base unit.</p> <p>Avoid placing the unit near other electronic devices that may cause interference (e.g., microwaves, Wi-Fi routers).</p>
