

# AIXPI 30X LED Illuminated Handheld Magnifying Glass

Model: L102

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your AIXPI 30X LED Illuminated Handheld Magnifying Glass, Model L102. This device is designed to assist with detailed tasks such as reading small print, inspecting coins, jewelry, and other intricate objects, particularly beneficial for individuals with low vision or macular degeneration. Please read this manual thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Avoid Direct Sunlight:** Never expose the magnifying glass to direct sunlight. The lens can concentrate sunlight, creating a fire hazard or causing permanent eye damage if viewed directly.
- **Battery Safety:** Use only the specified battery type (2x AA). Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries (alkaline, standard, rechargeable). Insert batteries with correct polarity. Remove batteries if the device will not be used for an extended period.
- **Choking Hazard:** Keep batteries and small parts away from children to prevent accidental ingestion.
- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth for cleaning the lens. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals that could scratch or damage the lens and housing.

## 4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The AIXPI L102 magnifying glass features a real glass lens with 30X magnification and 12 integrated LED lights for enhanced visibility. It is designed with a comfortable handle for handheld use.

## 5. SETUP

### 5.1 Battery Installation

1. Locate the battery compartment on the handle of the magnifying glass.
2. Gently slide open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert two (2) AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+ and -) as indicated inside the compartment.
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

## A Smooth Handle

The handle is polished, and the grip is more comfortable and smooth.

## 6. OPERATION

### 6.1 Using the Magnifying Glass

1. Hold the magnifying glass by the handle.
2. Position the lens over the object or text you wish to magnify.
3. Adjust the distance between the lens and the object until the image appears clear and in focus. The optimal focal distance will vary slightly depending on the object and individual vision.

## 6.2 Activating the LED Light

1. Locate the power button on the handle, typically a black switch.
2. Slide the button to the 'ON' position to activate the 12 LED lights around the lens.
3. Slide the button to the 'OFF' position when the light is no longer needed to conserve battery life.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

### 7.1 Cleaning the Lens

To maintain optimal clarity, regularly clean the glass lens. Use a soft, clean, lint-free microfiber cloth. For stubborn smudges, lightly dampen the cloth with a small amount of lens cleaning solution or water. Avoid using paper towels, facial tissues, or abrasive cleaners as these can scratch the lens.

### 7.2 Battery Care

If the LED lights dim or do not turn on, replace the AA batteries. Always dispose of used batteries responsibly according to local regulations. Remove batteries if the device is stored for extended periods to prevent leakage.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
LED lights do not turn on.	Batteries are dead or incorrectly installed.	Replace batteries with new AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Image is blurry or unclear.	Incorrect focal distance or dirty lens.	Adjust the distance between the lens and the object. Clean the lens as described in Section 7.1.
Magnifying glass feels heavy.	This model features a real glass lens, which contributes to its weight.	This is a characteristic of the product due to its real glass lens construction.


**Figure 9:** Visual representation of the 30X real glass lens, highlighting its material and magnification capability.
