1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Epson PowerLite L610U Laser Projector. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your projector. Please read it thoroughly before using the product and keep it for future reference. The PowerLite L610U is designed for versatile use in business, education, and home cinema environments, offering a high-resolution display of 1920 x 1200.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please observe the following safety precautions to prevent damage to the projector and ensure your safety:

- **Do not look directly into the projector lens** when the projector is on, as the bright light source can cause eye damage.
- **Do not block the ventilation openings** on the projector. Overheating can cause malfunction or fire.
- **Do not place the projector on an unstable surface**. It may fall, causing serious injury or damage.
- **Do not expose the projector to rain or moisture** to avoid electric shock or fire.
- **Use only the power cord supplied** with the projector.
- **Unplug the projector** from the power outlet before cleaning or when not in use for extended periods.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Epson PowerLite L610U Laser Projector
- Power Cable
- Remote Control with Batteries
- User Manual (this document)
- CD-ROM with documentation (if applicable)
- Lens Cap

4. SETUP

4.1 Projector Placement

Choose a stable, level surface for your projector. Ensure adequate space around the projector for ventilation. The projector dimensions are approximately 22.5 x 21.5 x 10 inches, and it weighs 26 pounds. Consider these measurements when selecting a location or mounting solution.

4.2 Connecting Devices

The PowerLite L610U supports HDMI connectivity. Use an HDMI cable to connect your video source (e.g., laptop, Blu-ray player) to the projector's HDMI input port.

1. Connect one end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI output port on your video source.
2. Connect the other end of the HDMI cable to an available HDMI input port on the projector.
3. For audio, the projector features a built-in speaker. If external audio is desired, connect an audio cable from the projector's audio output (if available) or your source device to an external sound system.

4.3 Power Connection

1. Plug the power cable into the projector's AC inlet.
2. Plug the other end of the power cable into a grounded electrical outlet.

5. OPERATING THE PROJECTOR

5.1 Turning On/Off

- **To Turn On:** Press the power button on the projector's control panel or the remote control. The power indicator light will illuminate.
- **To Turn Off:** Press the power button again. A confirmation message may appear; press the power button once more to confirm shutdown. The projector will enter a cooling cycle before fully powering down.

5.2 Basic Functions

- **Input Source Selection:** Use the 'Source' or 'Input' button on the remote control or projector panel to cycle through available input sources (e.g., HDMI1, HDMI2).
- **Focus and Zoom:** Adjust the focus and zoom rings on the projector lens to achieve a clear and appropriately sized image.
- **Keystone Correction:** If the image appears trapezoidal, use the keystone correction function (usually found in the menu or via dedicated buttons on the remote) to square the image.
- **Menu Navigation:** Use the 'Menu' button to access settings. Navigate using the arrow buttons and confirm selections

with the 'Enter' button.

- **Built-In Speaker:** The projector includes a built-in speaker for audio output. Adjust the volume using the remote control or projector panel.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning the Projector

- **Exterior:** Wipe the projector casing with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. For stubborn dirt, dampen the cloth slightly with water and a mild detergent, then wipe dry.
- **Lens:** Gently wipe the lens with a lens cleaning cloth or lens tissue specifically designed for optical surfaces. Do not use abrasive cleaners or excessive force.
- **Air Filter:** Regularly check and clean the air filter to ensure proper ventilation and prevent overheating. Refer to the projector's on-screen menu for filter maintenance reminders.

6.2 Laser Light Source

The PowerLite L610U uses a laser light source, which typically requires no replacement under normal operating conditions. If you experience issues with brightness or color, consult the troubleshooting section or contact Epson support.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter problems with your projector, refer to the following common issues and solutions:

- **No Image Displayed:**
 - Ensure the projector is powered on and the input source is correctly selected.
 - Check all cable connections (HDMI) between the projector and the source device.
 - Verify the source device is powered on and outputting a signal.
- **Image is Blurry:**
 - Adjust the focus ring on the projector lens.
 - Ensure the projection surface is flat and the projector is at an appropriate distance.
- **Image is Distorted (Trapezoidal):**
 - Use the keystone correction function to adjust the image shape.
 - Position the projector as perpendicular to the screen as possible.
- **No Sound from Built-in Speaker:**
 - Check the volume level on the projector and the source device.
 - Ensure the audio output from the source device is enabled and correctly routed.
- **Projector Overheating Warning:**
 - Ensure the ventilation openings are not blocked.
 - Clean the air filter if it is dirty.
 - Operate the projector in a well-ventilated area.
