1. INTRODUCTION

4. MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES

4.1 Air Filter Replacement

1. **Prepare:** Ensure the air compressor is turned off, unplugged, and completely depressurized.

2. **Locate Filter:** Identify the air intake filter housing on your compressor.
3. **Remove Old Filter:** Carefully open the filter housing and remove the old, dirty air filter. Note its orientation.
4. **Clean Housing:** Wipe down the inside of the filter housing to remove any dust or debris.
5. **Install New Filter:** Insert one of the new Speedaire air filters into the housing, ensuring it is seated correctly and oriented as the old one was.
6. **Secure Housing:** Close and secure the filter housing.

4.2 Synthetic Oil Change

1. **Prepare:** Ensure the air compressor is turned off, unplugged, and completely depressurized. Place a suitable drain pan beneath the oil drain plug.
2. **Drain Old Oil:** Carefully remove the oil drain plug (and possibly the oil fill cap to aid draining) and allow all the old oil to drain into the pan.
3. **Replace Plug:** Once drained, replace the oil drain plug and tighten it to the manufacturer's specified torque.
4. **Add New Oil:** Locate the oil fill port. Slowly pour the new Speedaire synthetic oil into the compressor's crankcase. Use the compressor's oil level indicator (dipstick or sight glass) to ensure the correct fill level. Do not overfill.
5. **Replace Cap:** Securely replace the oil fill cap.
6. **Check for Leaks:** After starting the compressor for a short period, check for any leaks around the drain plug or fill cap.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues related to the use of the maintenance kit components.

- **Filter Not Fitting:** Ensure you have the correct kit for your compressor model. Verify the filter's orientation before attempting to install. Do not force the filter.
- **Oil Leaks After Change:** Check that the oil drain plug and oil fill cap are securely tightened. Inspect the drain plug washer/gasket for damage and replace if necessary.
- **Compressor Performance Issues After Maintenance:** Double-check that all components (filters, caps, plugs) are correctly installed and secured. Ensure the oil level is within the recommended range. If issues persist, consult your compressor's specific troubleshooting guide or a qualified technician.
- **Incorrect Oil Level Reading:** Ensure the compressor is on a level surface when checking the oil level. Allow sufficient time for oil to settle after filling.
